





- Provides a legally binding framework to protect the marine environment at the regional level
- 16 Regional Seas Conventions and 2 Action Plans
- Governed by the participating countries through the Conference of <u>Parties (or the Intergovernmental Meeting)</u>






UNEP Northwest Pacific Action Plan (NOWPAP)

- Overall goal: Protection of the marine and coastal environment in the region










NOWPAP Mechanism






NOWPAP Regional Action Plan on Marine Litter

NOWPAP DELTA - Joint Oil Spill Response Exercise (July 2016, Weihai, China)



A total of 18 vessels, 1 rescue helicopter, 2 unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV) and 400 personnel mobilised by China MSA, and 1 specific oil spill response vessel and 13 staffs dispatched from KCG





Biodiversity Conservation

- Regional Action Plan on Marine and Coastal Biodiversity Conservation (RAP BIO) – <u>to be approved in 2022</u>
- A database on IUCN Red List species in the NOWPAP region
- Assessment of seagrass blue carbon in the NOWPAP region
