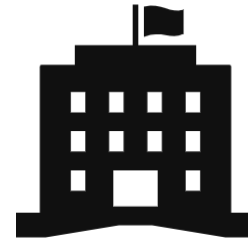

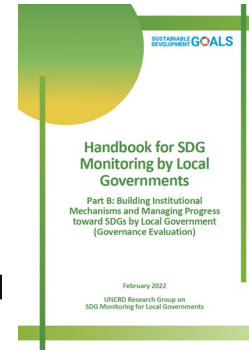

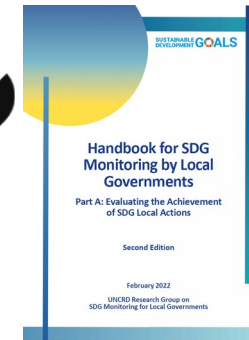

Information Dissemination

1. Framework of **Governance Evaluation**

- Consisting of **four steps** which are necessary to initiate and implement the **SDGs**
- Setting **“quantitative” indicators** that can be extracted from various plans, council minutes, etc. so that data can be collected by all local governments

1. Institutional Mechanisms

- Leadership of Mayor
- Responsible departments and personnel
- Industry-academia-government-citizens collaboration
- Interest of local councilors

2. Goal setting

- Policy and plans about SDGs
- Reflection of SDGs in existing plans
- Setting numerical targets
- Perspective of inclusiveness

3. Monitoring

- Data collection
- Participation in external accreditation system
- Dissemination of information to citizens
- Dissemination of information domestically and internationally

4. Partnership

- Citizens' understanding of SDGs
- Corporate partnership
- Partnership with universities and other activity groups
- International partnership

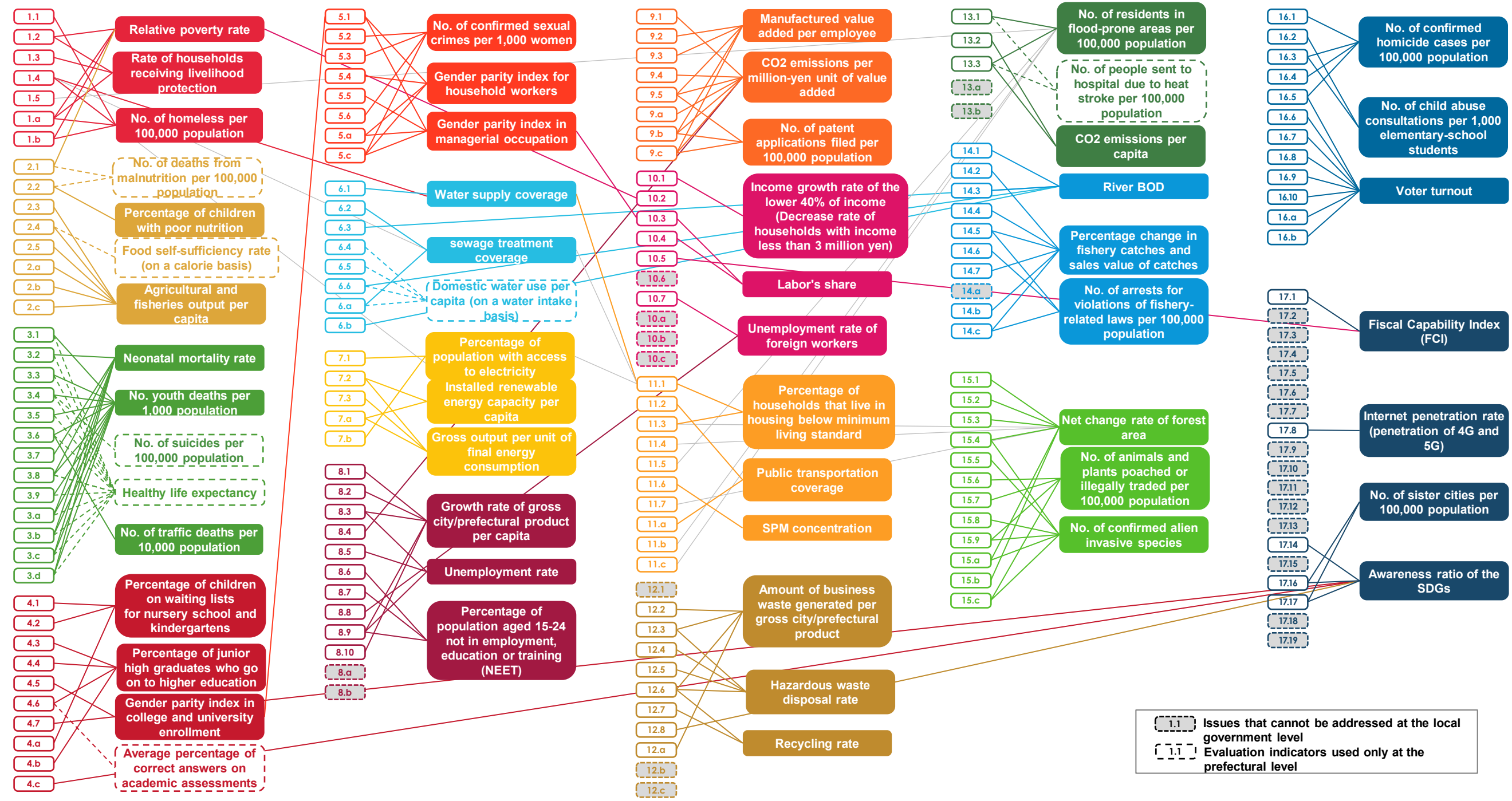

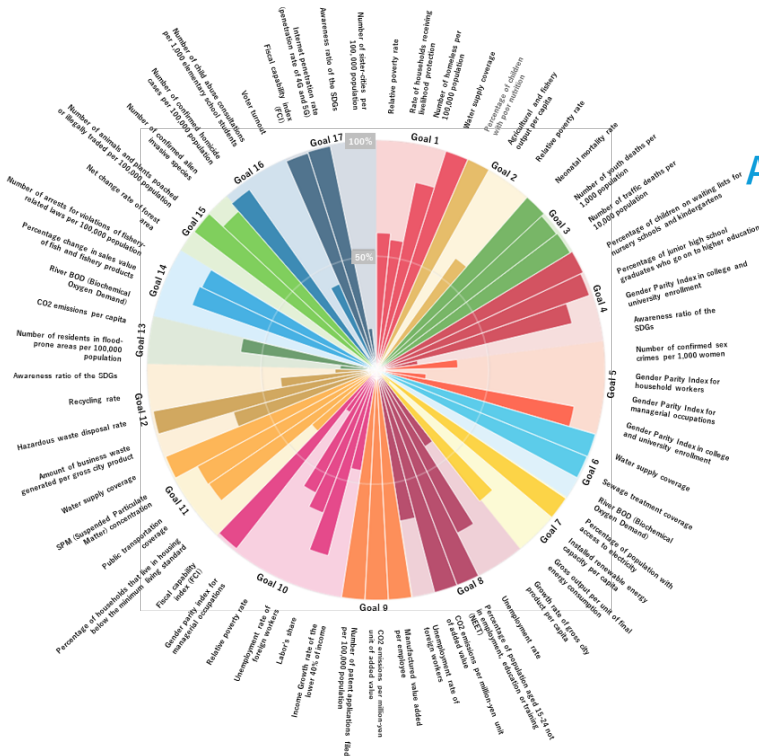
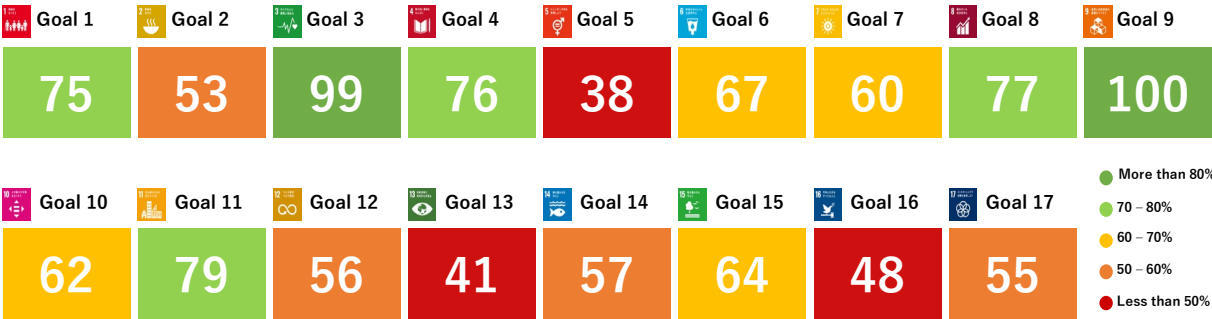
Relationship between indicators and targets

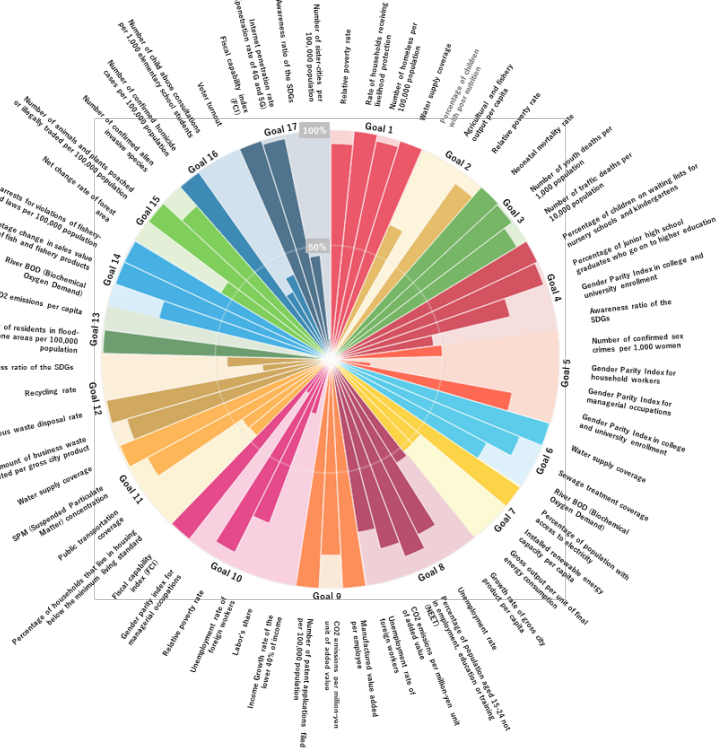
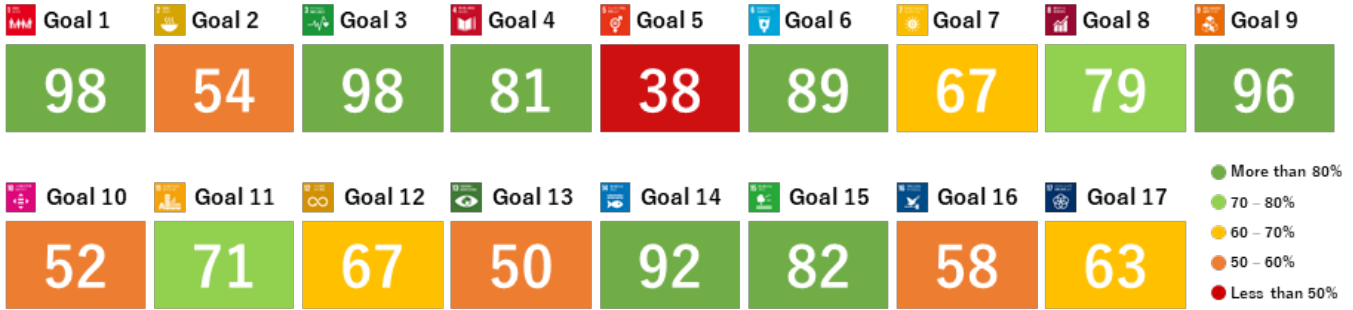
Achievement level for each goal



Achievement level for each indicator

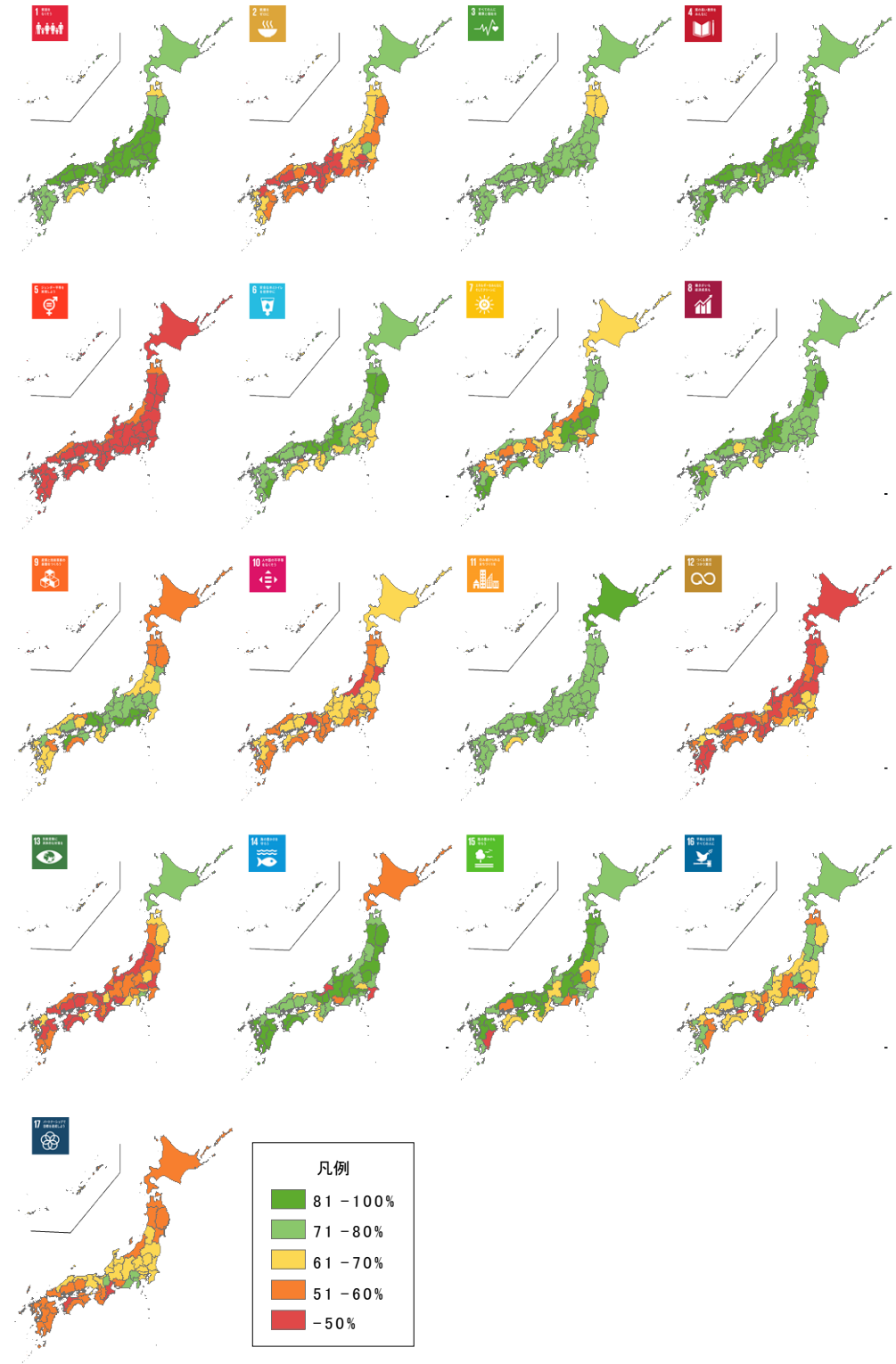

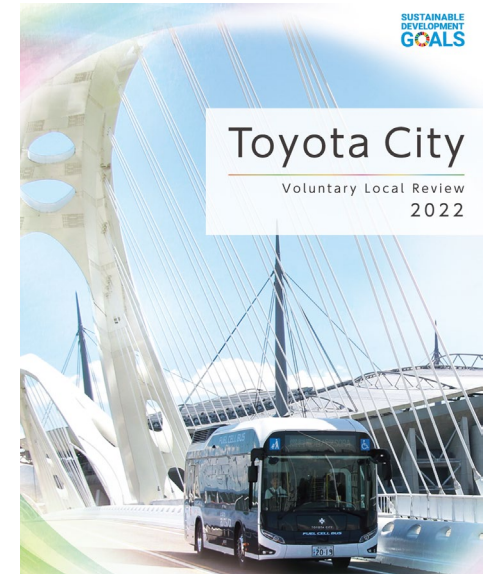

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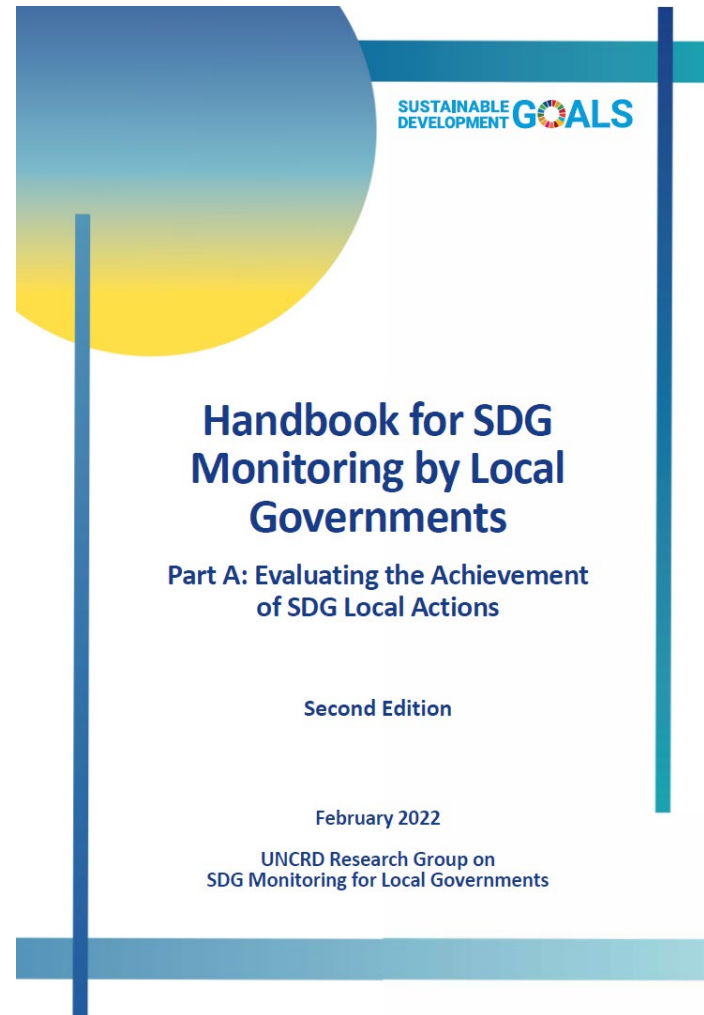
