Mr. Okhyun Yang is currently working as the Associate Research and Policy Development Expert at the United Nations Office for Sustainable Development (UNOSD). He has approximately 10 years of working experience in the field of climate change policy and its implementation and the urban planning. Before joining UNOSD, he worked for the Korea Environment Corporation, the Ministry of Environment of Republic of Korea, Greenhouse Gas Research Center of Korea and the Incheon Urban Corporation. He had participated in designing the Korea Emissions Trading Scheme (ETS) and the Target Management Scheme (TMS) by assisting to develop its guidelines. His main responsibility came with Monitoring, Reporting and Verification of Greenhouse Gas Emissions under ETS and TMS. He reviewed the GHG emissions reports and the Monitoring plans from those entities, and evaluated the plausibility and effectiveness of the reduction targets and general implementation. In addition to experiences in the field of Climate Change, he was supervisor in charge of construction for sewage treatment pipes/plants and involved in designing restoration projects of Incheon Metropolitan City.
