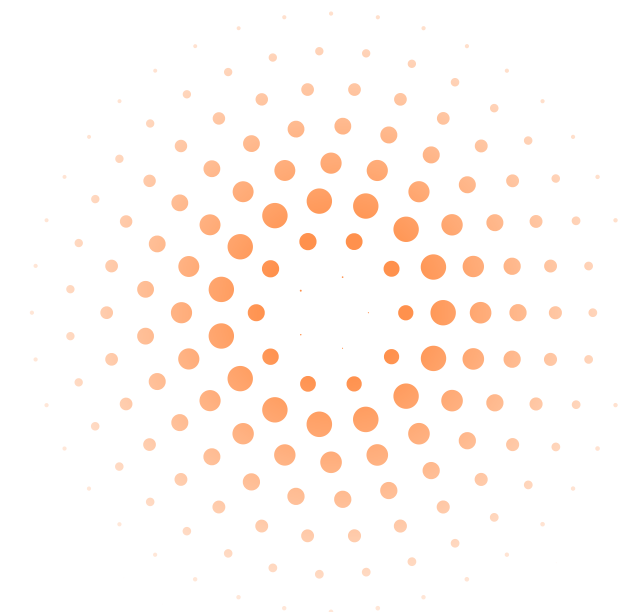

Total Population: 6.322 people

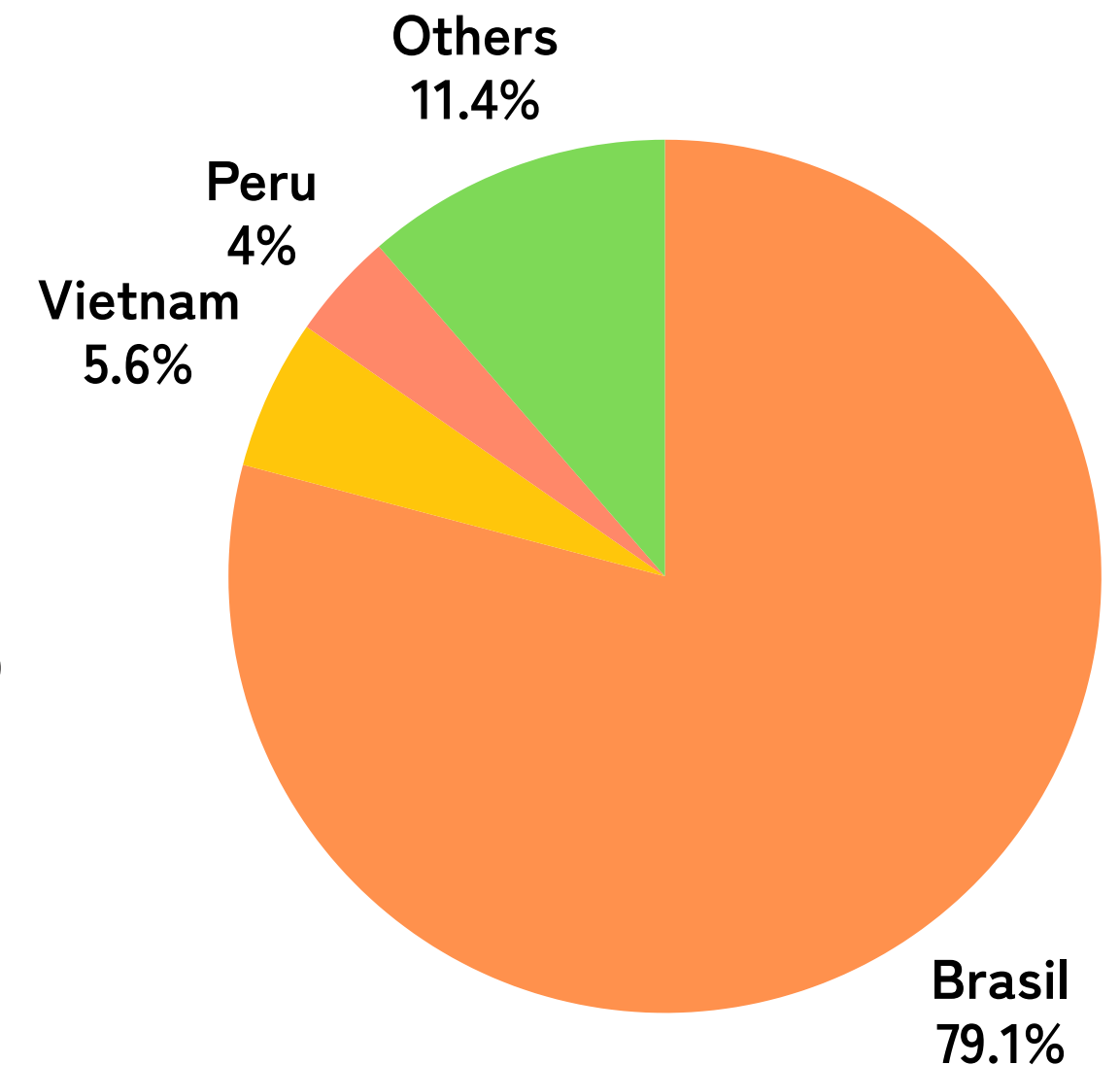
Foreign residents: 3.674 people 58,1%

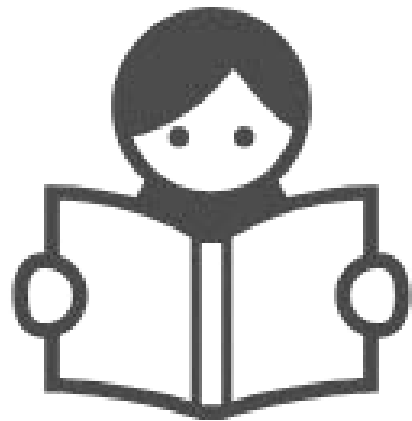

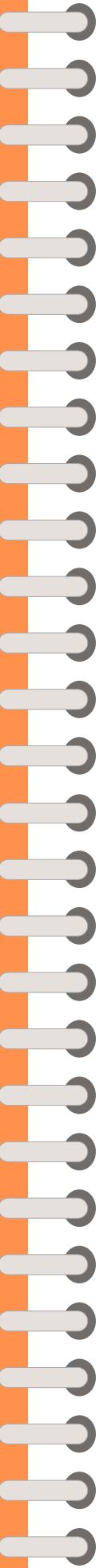

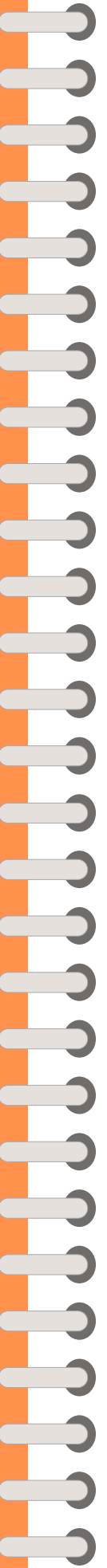
