

#### **SDGs** in the Pacific

- All countries have incorporated the SDGs into national policies and strategies.
- None of the 21 targets expected to be achieved by 2020 were achieved.
- It is also unlikely that the Pacific will achieve even 20% of the SDG targets by 2030.









## Vulnerabilities and inequality are increasing especially pronounced between urban and remote rural communities and amongst men and women, youth, elderly and persons with disabilities














## COVID-19 has further exacerbated our regions vulnerabilities
