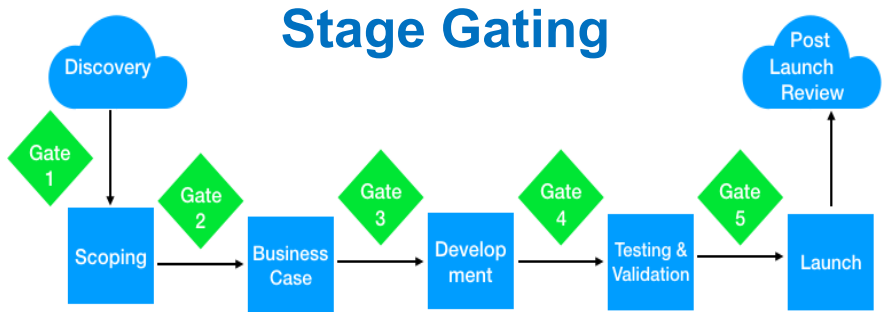

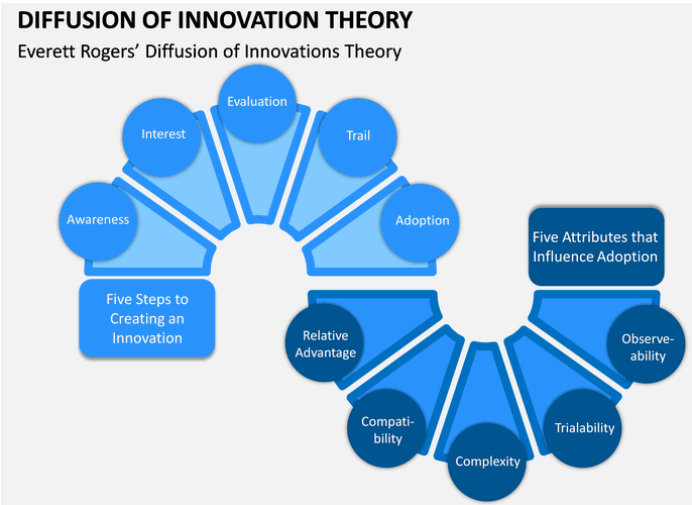

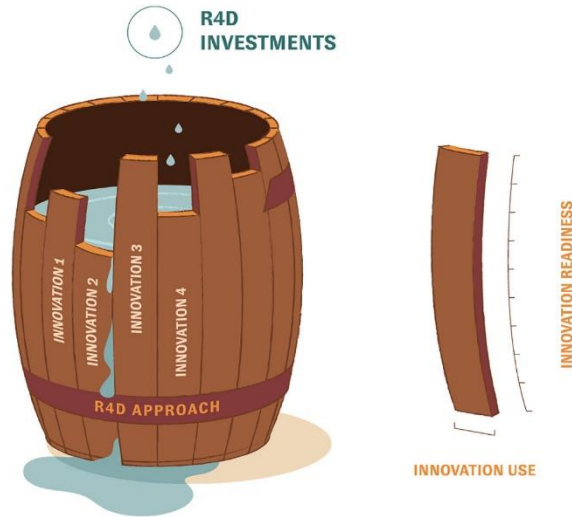
Stage Gate™ : 5 stage, 5 gate model as defined by R.C. Cooper in his 1994 paper.



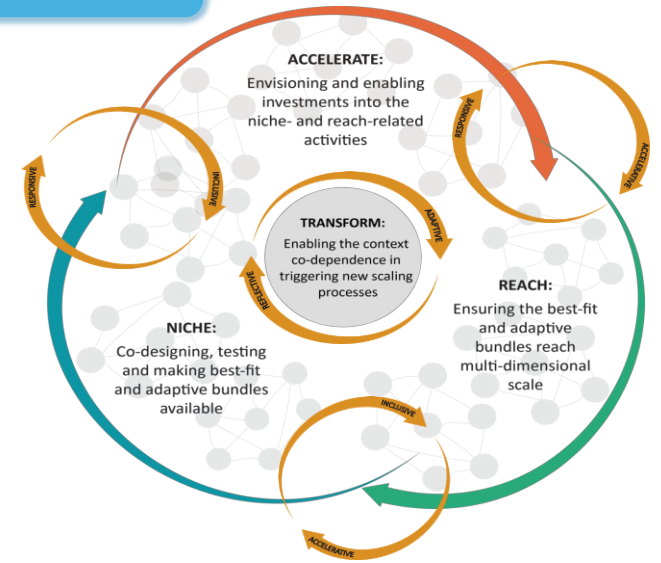
• Does a single approach fit all?



Innovation diffusion

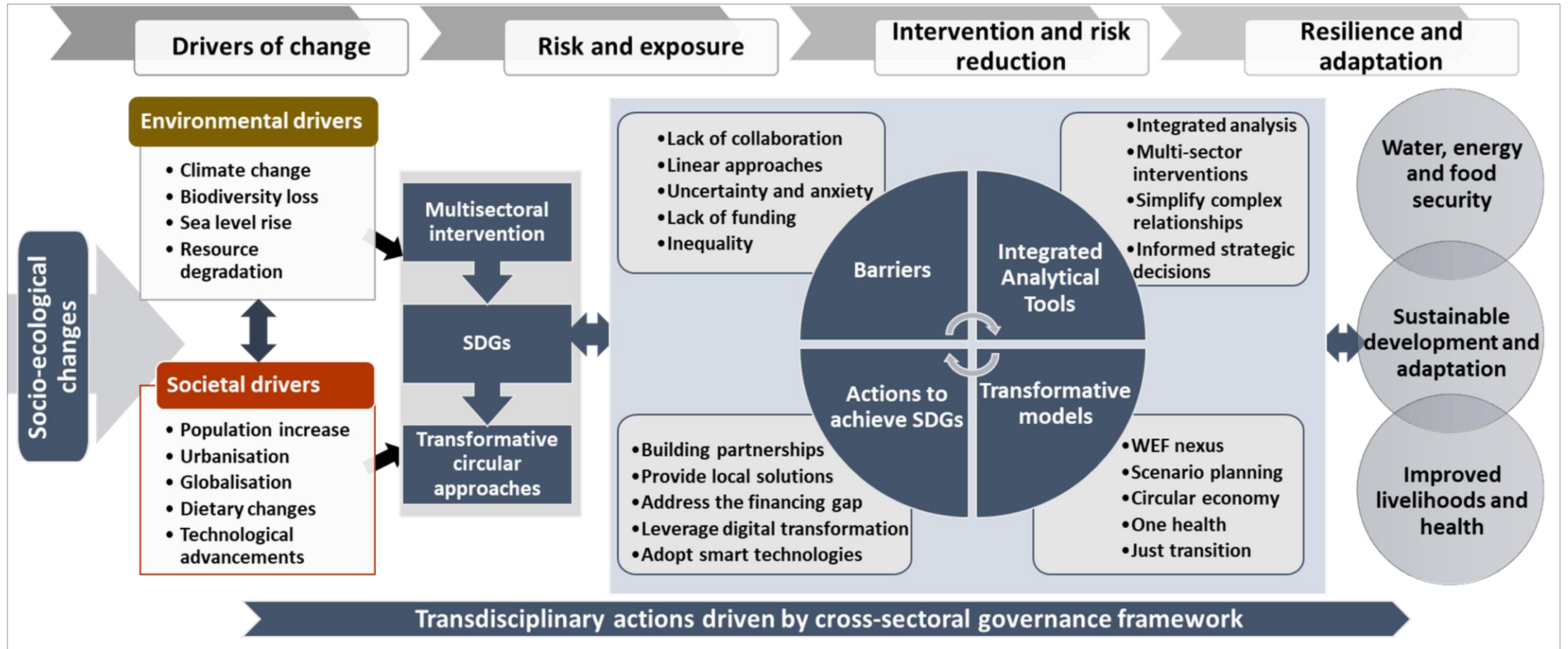


Scaling Readiness

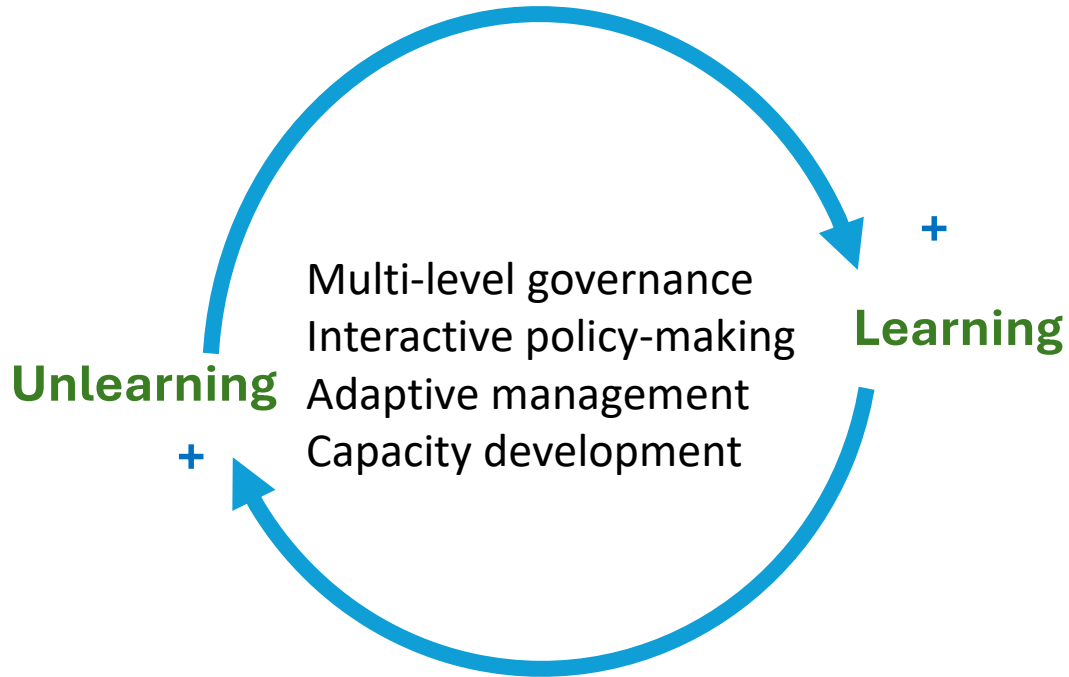


Adaptive scaling
