

1. What are the on-going national and regional cooperation activities, such as projects around water sector?

- Mano River Union Transboundary water resources management in Sierra Leone. The MRU countries are, Sierra Leone, Liberia, Guinea and Ivory Coast.
- ADB funded third rural water supply project in Cambodia. The project cover 10 provinces and it has 3 components: Rural water supply infrastructure, rural sanitation infrastructure, and capacity development.
- Data collection on sanitation on water supply in Iraq funded by WHO and UNICEF. Data is collected every four years.

- The impact of solar pumping on ground water in Pakistan, Bangladesh, India and Nepal. It is a 4year project funded by the world bank
- FCDO-UK funded project on ground water management system in Pakistan
- IWRM in the Congo basin implemented by CICOS international commission of Congo basin. It is a regional project implemented in the following countries: DRC, Gabon Brazaville, Gabon, Cameroon, Angola, Zambia and South Africa. The objective is to collect and share hydrological and Meteorological data.
- Constructions of a water treatment plant with funding from Japan in Samoa
- Improvement of onsite sanitation funded by EU in Samoa
- BONEX project in Tunisia. It involves using IOT (Internet of things) to monitor water quality and improve irrigation water scheduling. 17 partners including private sector are involved in the implementation

2. Are there best practices on water resources management in a country that may be replicated by other countries?

- Using rainwater harvesting for aquifer recharge in Pakistan
- Shifting from surface to drip irrigation in Iraq
- Creation of Congolese office of water to regulate and manage water resources
- Community participation in the management of water supply in Cambodia.
- Using both electronic and print media for awareness raising and sensitization in Sierra Leone
- Community consultation in Samoa
- The use of Apps to assist farmers in irrigation water scheduling in Tunisia
