who need the **language support for studying**

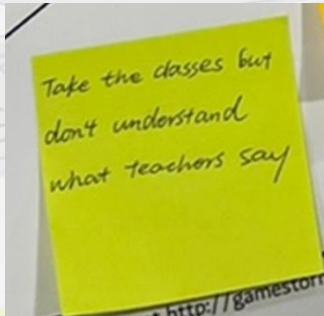
Problem Situation:

because **1.5 million refugee children missing out on primary school**

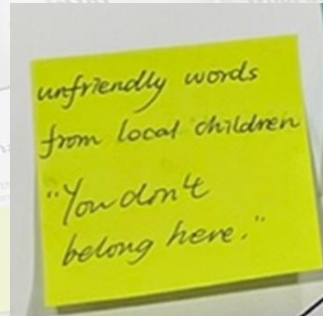
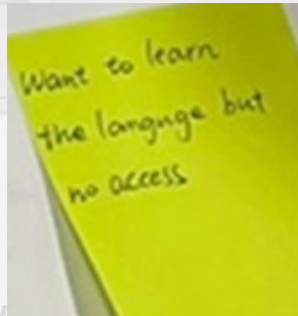
since they **cannot understand the language** used in learning materials of the host country (UNHCR).



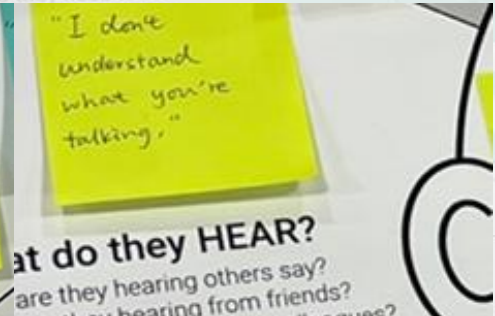
Define the Target's Needs: Empathy Map

They are often not **included** in school community



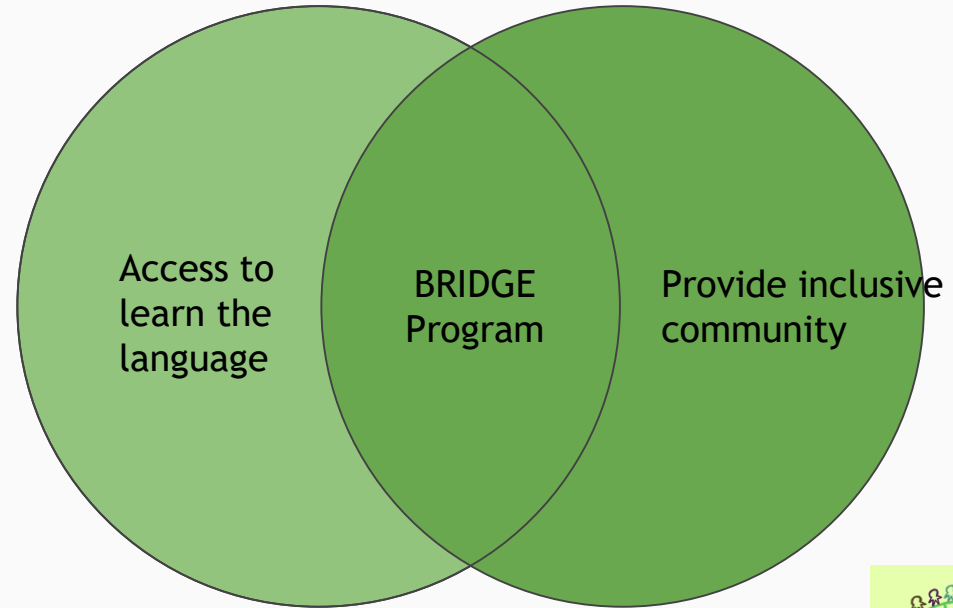
Target's Needs:

“Creating a program composed of educational activities designed to enable the refugee students to practice the host country’s language and social integration with the non-refugee students.”

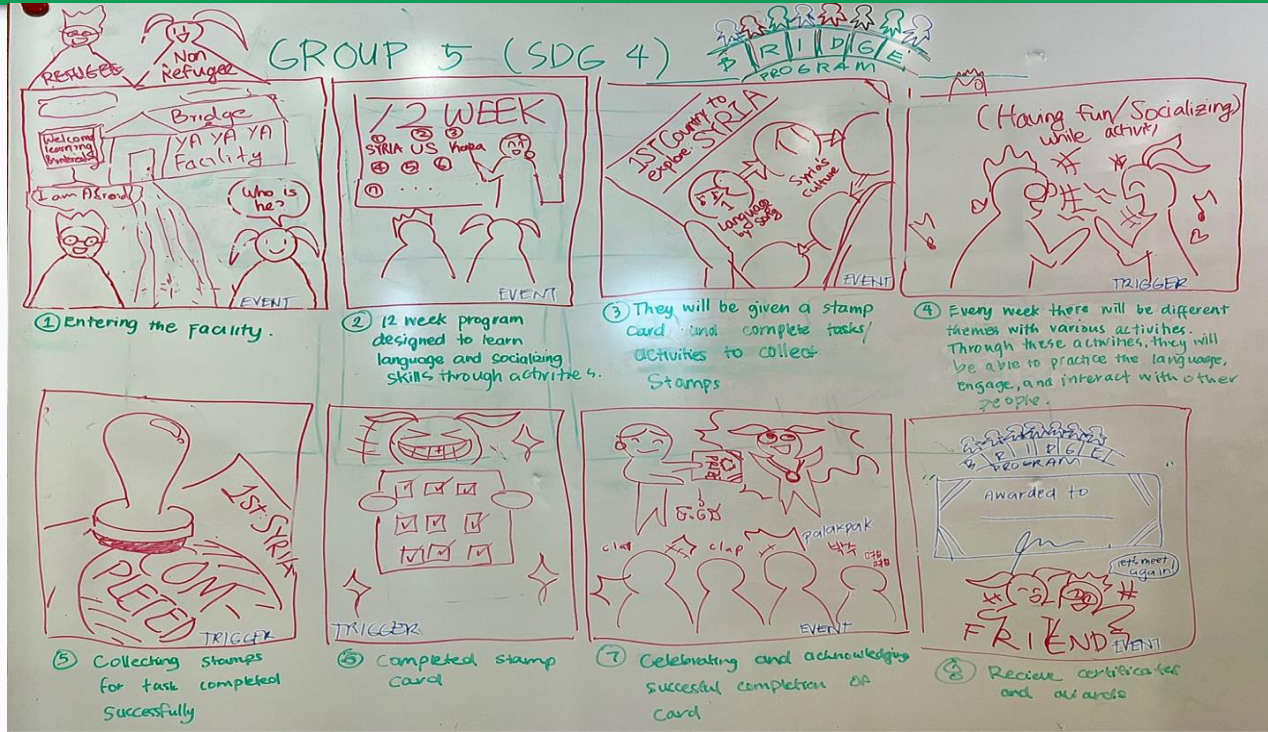

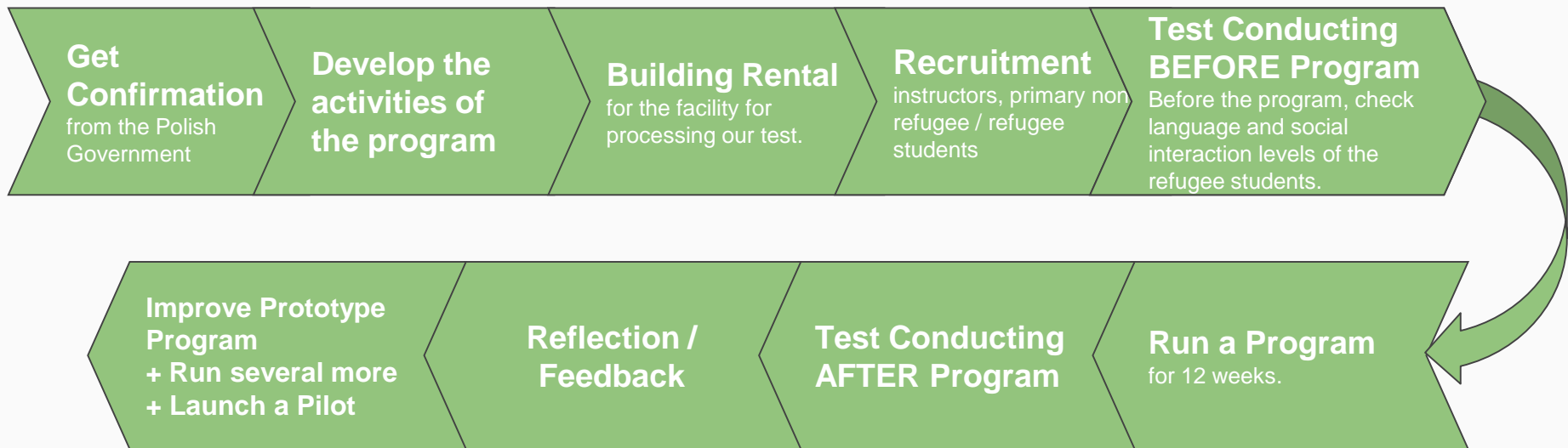
When? Once a week during weekends
