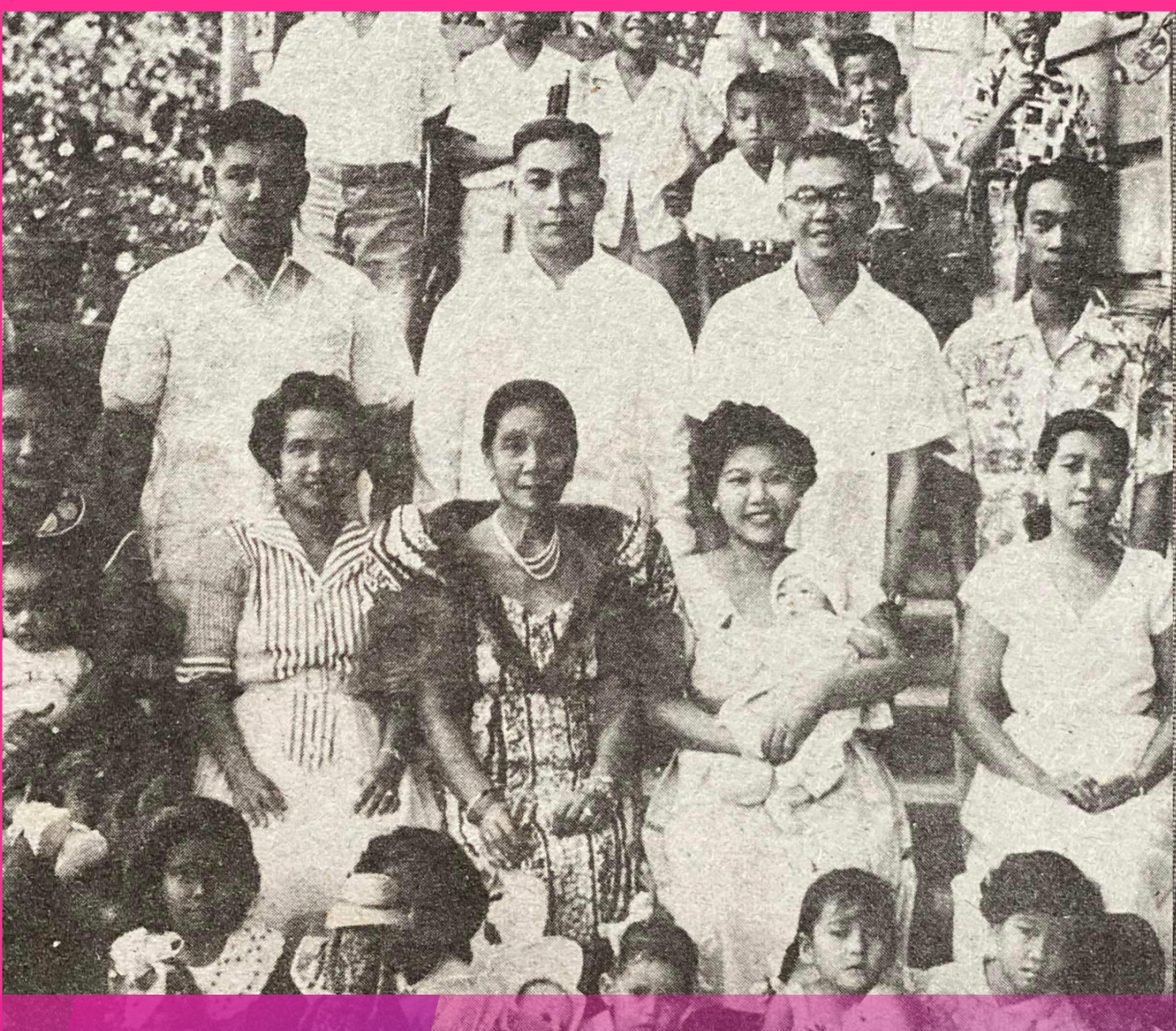

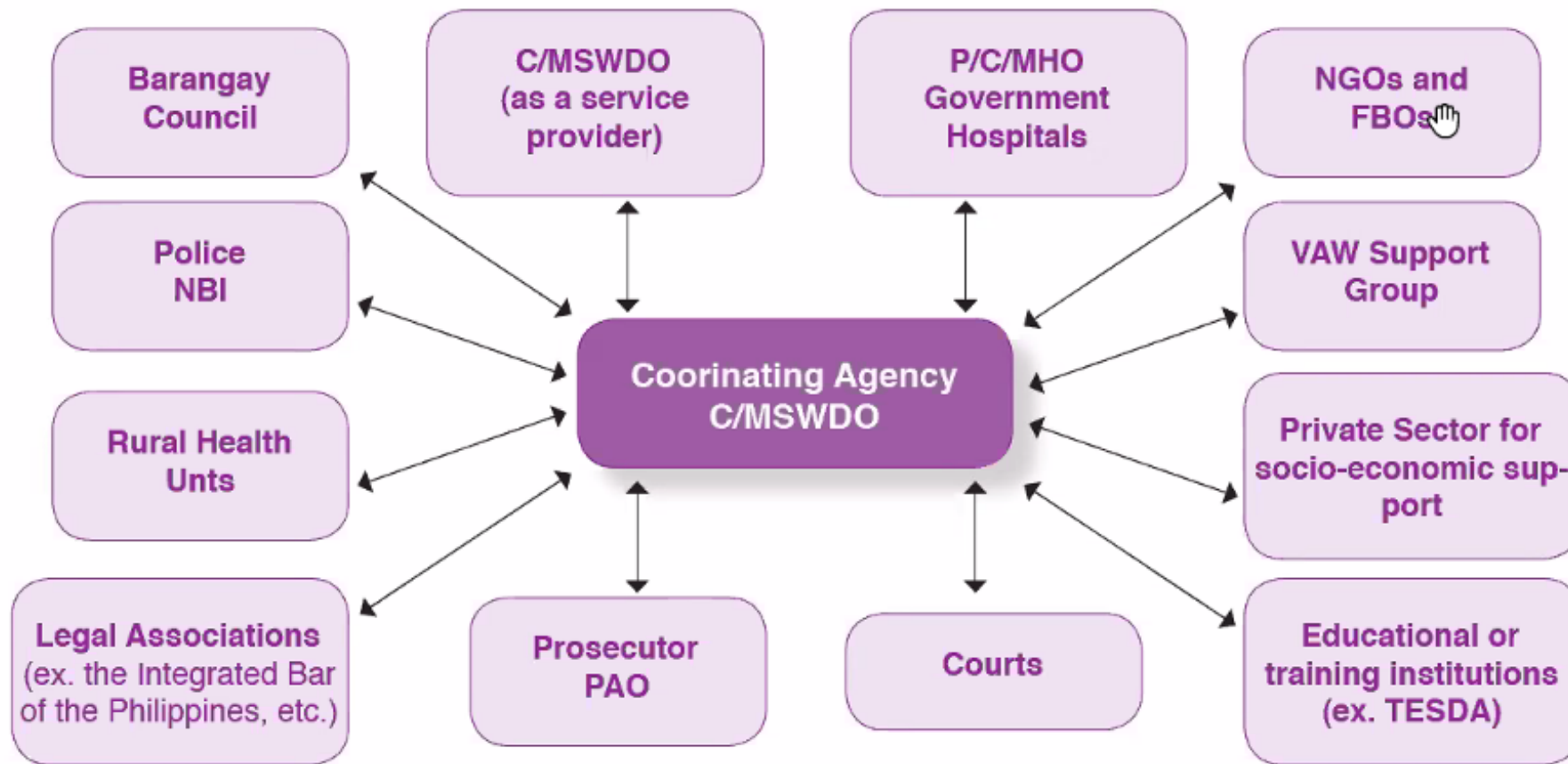

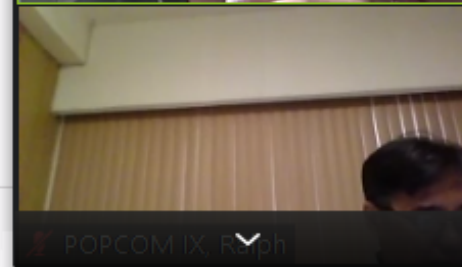
Chart 3. Referral Network in the Case Management of VAW Victims-Survivors

# **Ordinance 543**

## **Anti-Discrimination Ordinance of Zamboanga City**

The Ordinance prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, civil and social status, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, language, religion, national or social origin, culture and ethnicity, property, birth or age, disability and health status, creed and ideological beliefs, and physical appearance

## **Amended Gender and Development (GAD) Code**

The first GAD Code of Zamboanga City was established in 2010 and was amended in 2016, expanding provisions that would cater and address the needs of men, women and persons with diverse SOGIESC across all agencies, Private, Public, CSO, and POs to mainstream Gender.
