Delivery Mechanisms

Country Engagement

Working with member countries, development partners and implementing partners, we catalyze support for country requests to implement and enhance NDCs.

Knowledge & Learning

Facilitating the exchange of best practices, lessons learned and key resources to scale up climate action.

Access to Finance

Supporting countries to access necessary financing to implement their NDCs faster and more effectively.



Policy, Strategy & Legislation


PARTNERSHIP SUPPORT FOR NDC DEVELOPMENT

2020 NDC SUPPORT

- Focused on three pillars: Process, Quality, and Ambition
- Deployed over USD 55 million in support of 67 developing country members' NDC update efforts, delivered through the technical and financial contributions of 46 partners.


Global Call for NDCs and LT-LEDS alignment, update and enhancement (2022-2025)

- Draws on members' resources, establishing coordination arrangements with partners' initiatives*.
- **Partnership Action Fund,** a complementary, last-resort funding mechanism to strengthen members' responses and to fill gaps.
- To date, 53 countries have engaged with the initiative, attaining an 80% response rate.
- In the region, **16 countries** requesting support for the 2025 NDC and/or LT-LEDS development.

Tonga	Review progress against Tonga's second NDC. Develop and launch Tonga's NDC 3.0 in 2025. Review and update Tonga's LT-LEDS.	14 months	\$600,000	Request for Support Letter and Request for Support Form
Fiji	Technical assistance support to carry out a stocktake of progress against Fiji's second NDC, and to develop Fiji's NDC 3.0.	26 months	\$430,000	Request for Support Letter and Request for Support Form
RMI	Support for the development of their NDC 3.0 for 2025-2035.	18 months	\$400,000	Request for Support Letter and Request for Support Form

Montenegro	Conducting GHG emissions analysis from energy consumption (for electrification, cooking and heating) of households and MSMEs. Developing possible mitigation measures and financial instruments to support implementation, with an emphasis on financing instruments to attract private sector investment into renewable energy resources. Mongolia	Developing GHG Emission Inventory systems in selected provinces as part of the Carbon Neutral Cities program	FAO and Germany
Nepal	Developing country-specific emission factors for cement and brick industries and generating digital datasets. Providing recommendations for the use of cleaner technologies for lowering emissions from cement and brick industries.	UNDP with funding from PAF
PNG	Updating MRV system for REDD+ and improving its main functions including utilizing a satellite land monitoring system, and strengthening the National Forest Inventory (NFI) and the GHG Inventory (GHGI).	GGGI
