

The SDG Gender Index







Bending the Curve

- The <u>Bending the Curve</u> analysis looks at the pace and nature of change: are countries moving towards greater equality or in the wrong direction?
- The briefing uses a set of five indicators drawn from the SDG Gender Index to tell a meaningful story about the broader state of gender equality from the past to today, and projects trends on those five issues to 2030.






Senegal: Women's perception of their safety in public places

1 Even before COVID-19, global progress on gender equality was far too slow.




2 The pandemic has exposed economic discrimination against women.



Impact of COVID-19

- Progress was already too slow on gender equality, and COVID-19 is exacerbating this trend
- Many countries risk undermining progress made or even backsliding if the rights of girls an women are not prioritised
- The pandemic poses problems for gender data collection: without accurate data on the impact of the crisis on girls and women, response and recovery plans are gender blind
