Group work

Objective: Learn how the WMPSS works and provide feedback on the individual survey components

Questions to address:

1. Is the WMPSS user friendly – did you feel comfortable using it after only 30 minutes?
2. How relevant do you think the components, sub-component and questions are in terms of helping your country understand its progress and gaps on waste management?
3. How easy or hard would it be to complete the self-assessment based on information available in your country?
4. What are the top 3 things you think would need to be improved to make the WMPSS most useful to your country

Instructions for Facilitators

Group work: 30 minutes

4-5 groups divided into Francophone and Anglophone – 1 Facilitator per group

Each group uses at least two laptops to log into WMPSS using demo login details provided by Hannes.

Within each group the participants are divided up between available laptops and each laptop gets assigned a different survey component to review by Hannes.

If time permits the participants can review an additional component(s) of their choice.

The facilitator makes sure each laptop gets logged into WMPSS and ensures the group remembers to review the components with the group work questions in mind.

The facilitator makes sure to leave sufficient time to consolidate all the answers from the different laptops within the group – the whole group should agree on the answers rather than each laptop providing their own answers.

Summary: 10 minutes (2 minutes max per group)

Facilitator delivers summary of answers to group work questions

Plenary discussion: 25 minutes
