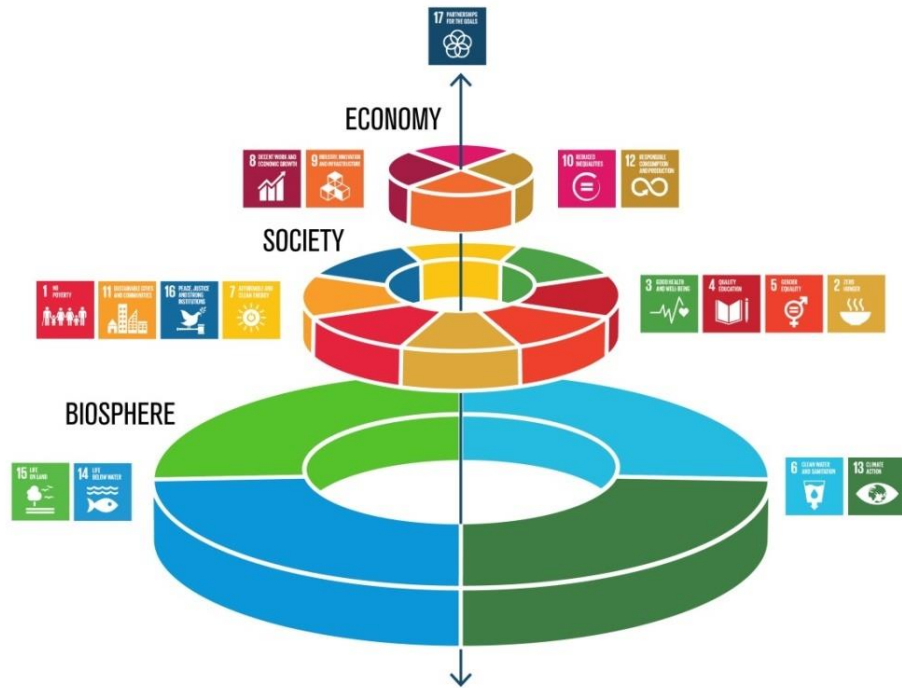

The diversity of the SDGs means they need input from a variety of groups to have comprehensive representation.

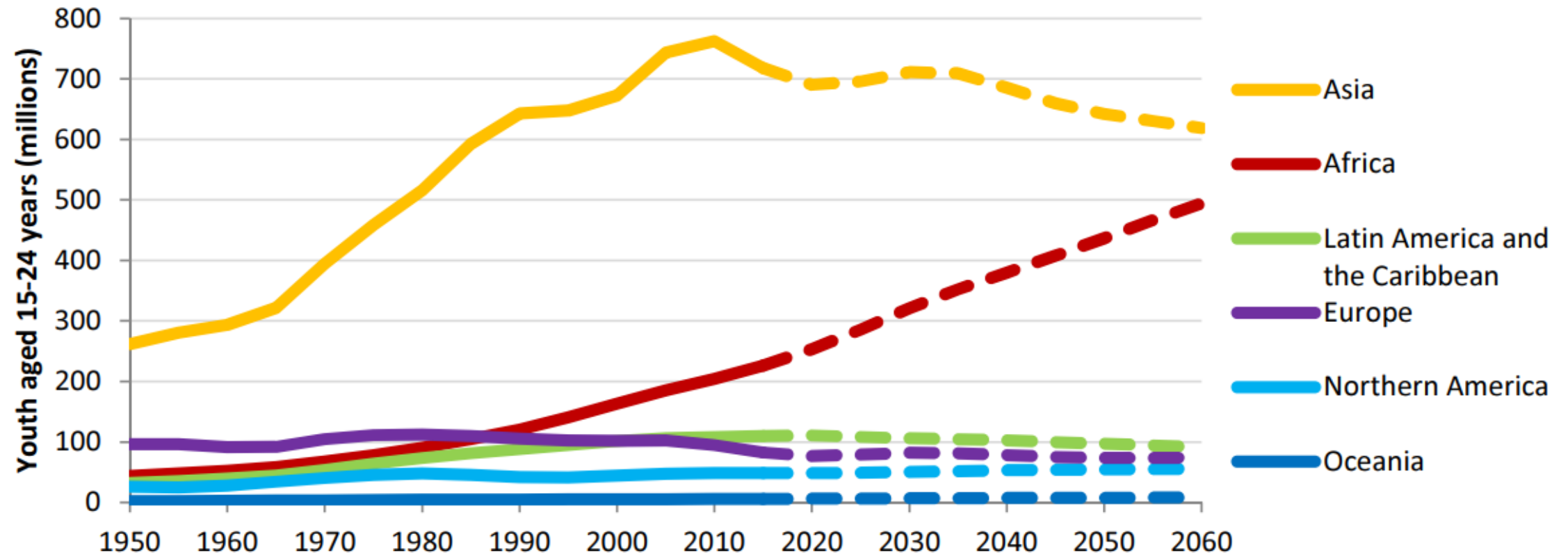
The UN has recognized the importance of 9 groups:

1. BROWSE ACTIONS:



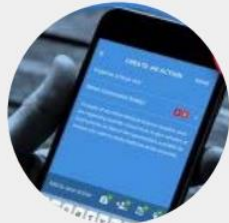
See what other people around you are doing to achieve SDGs and be inspired to take action on your own.

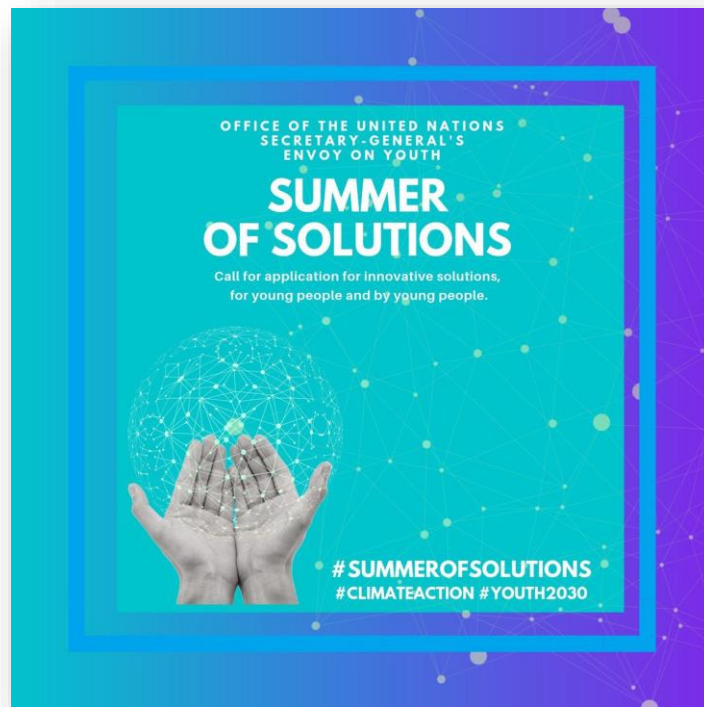
