About MuAN

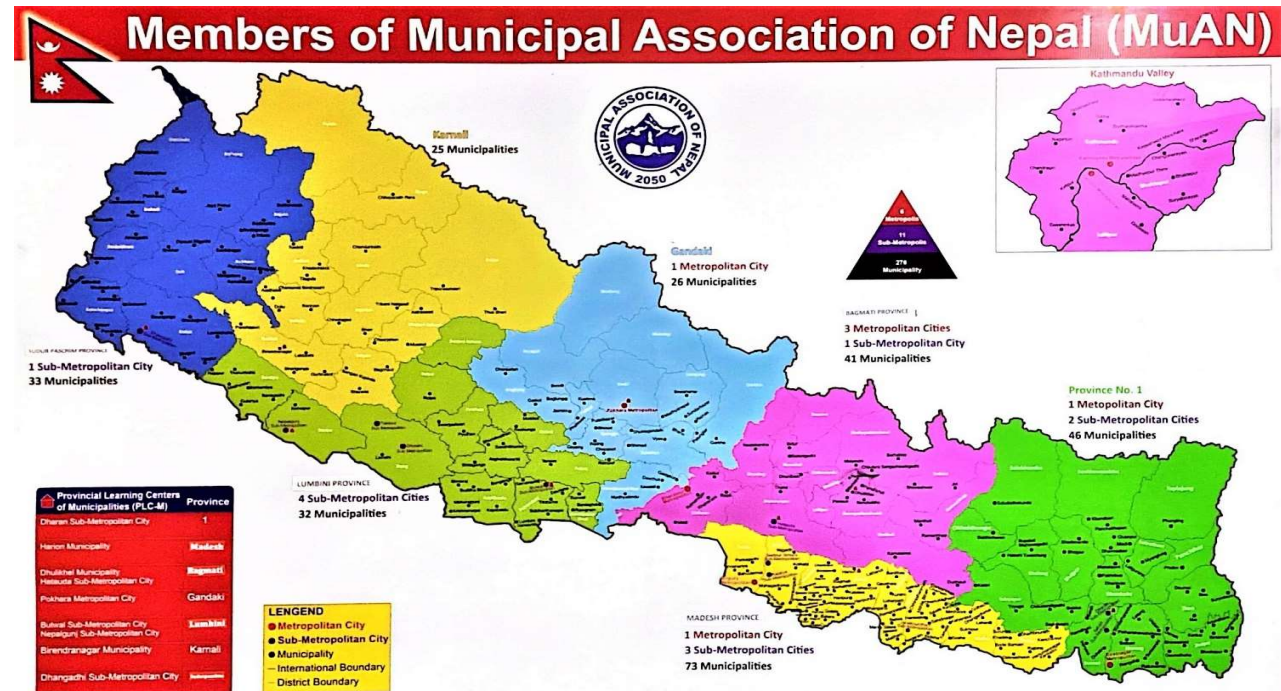
established in 1994, is an umbrella organization representing entire municipalities of Nepal, registered under the National Directive Act 1961 AD.

All 293 municipalities including metropolitan and sub-Metropolitan cities are members of MuAN.

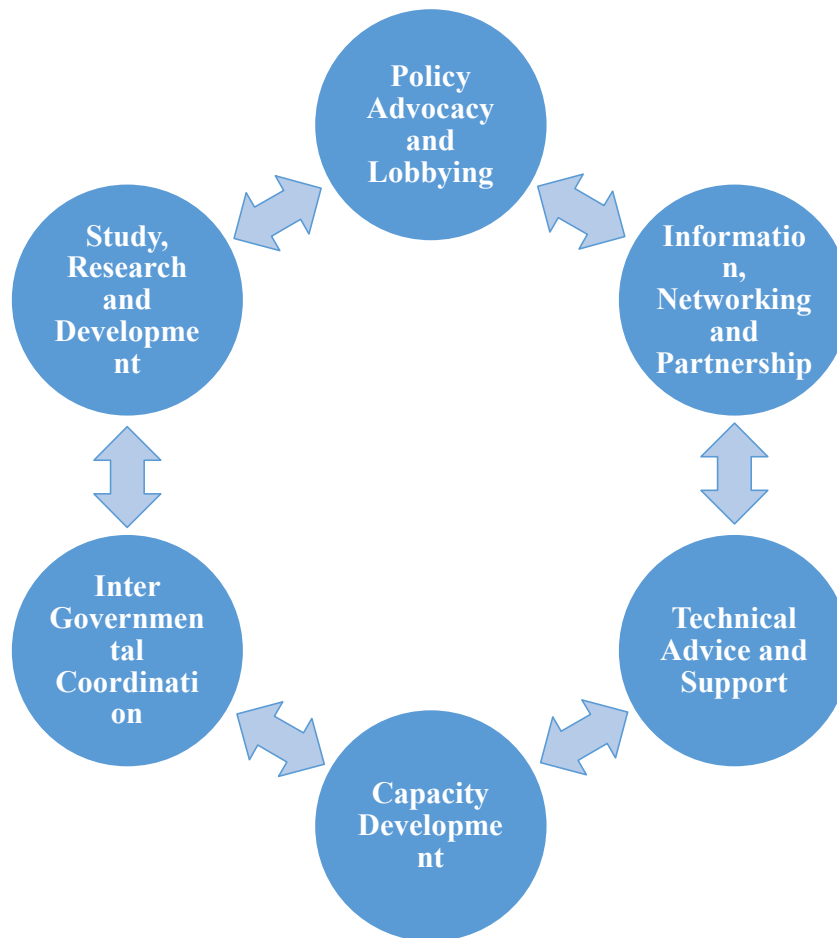
MuAN has successfully established its credibility as a national voice for Municipalities.

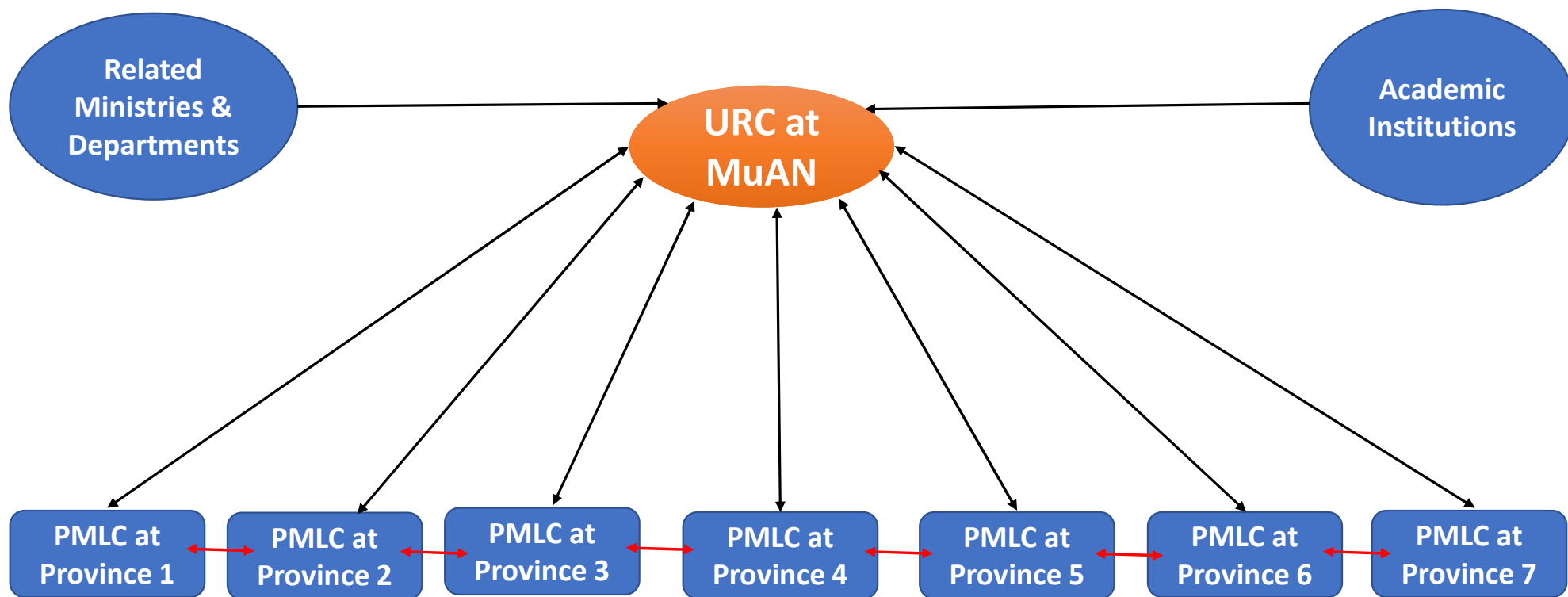
8. Basic Health and Sanitation

Some Key Intervention under MuNASS Project:

- For the first time, FSM Policy endorsed in all five pilots in Nepal; FSM Act and by-laws drafted.
- Increment of budget allocation for FSM in all five pilots in Nepal.
- SFD of Municipalities and its Institutionlization at National SDG reporting System.
- CWIS Guidelines in draft phase
- DPR of FSTP prepared for all five pilots in Nepal.
- Business Model and Business Plan prepared for all five pilots in Nepal.
- Sensitization orientation to elected representatives of all 293 municipalities through provinces.
- Technical Trainings to Municipal staff (Pilot and cluster municipalities).
- MuAN establishes Urban Resource Centre, PMLCs (Provincial Municipal Learning Centre) and FSM desk in all seven provinces.in Nepal.

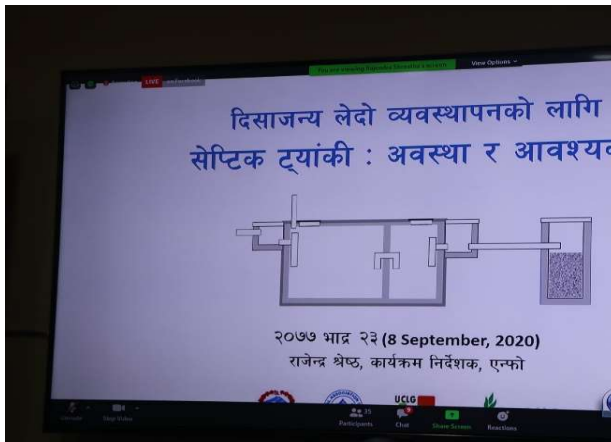
Policy

- MuAN developed 5 sub-national FSM policies for 5 pilot municipalities.

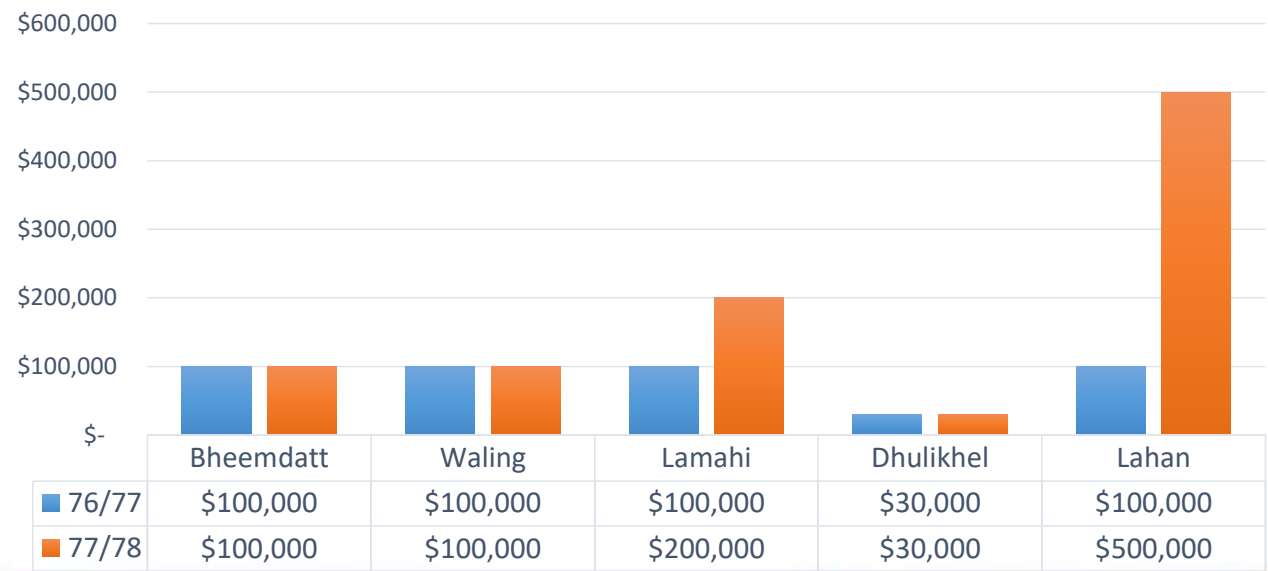
Advocacy

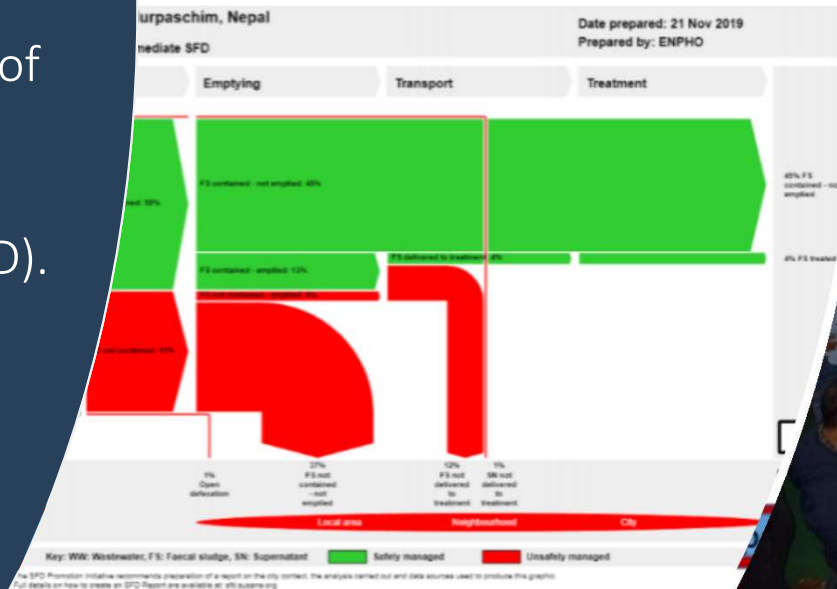
Capacity Building

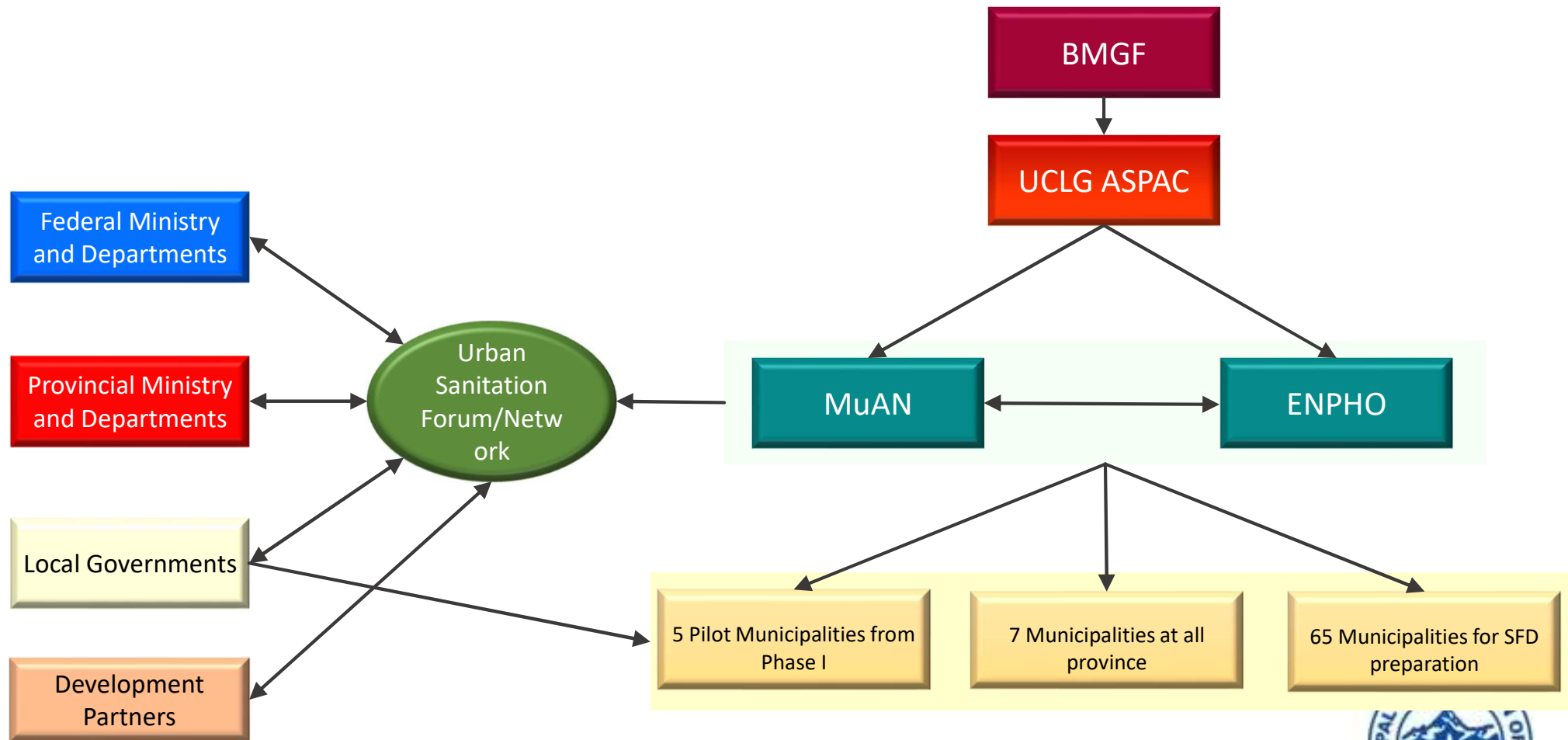

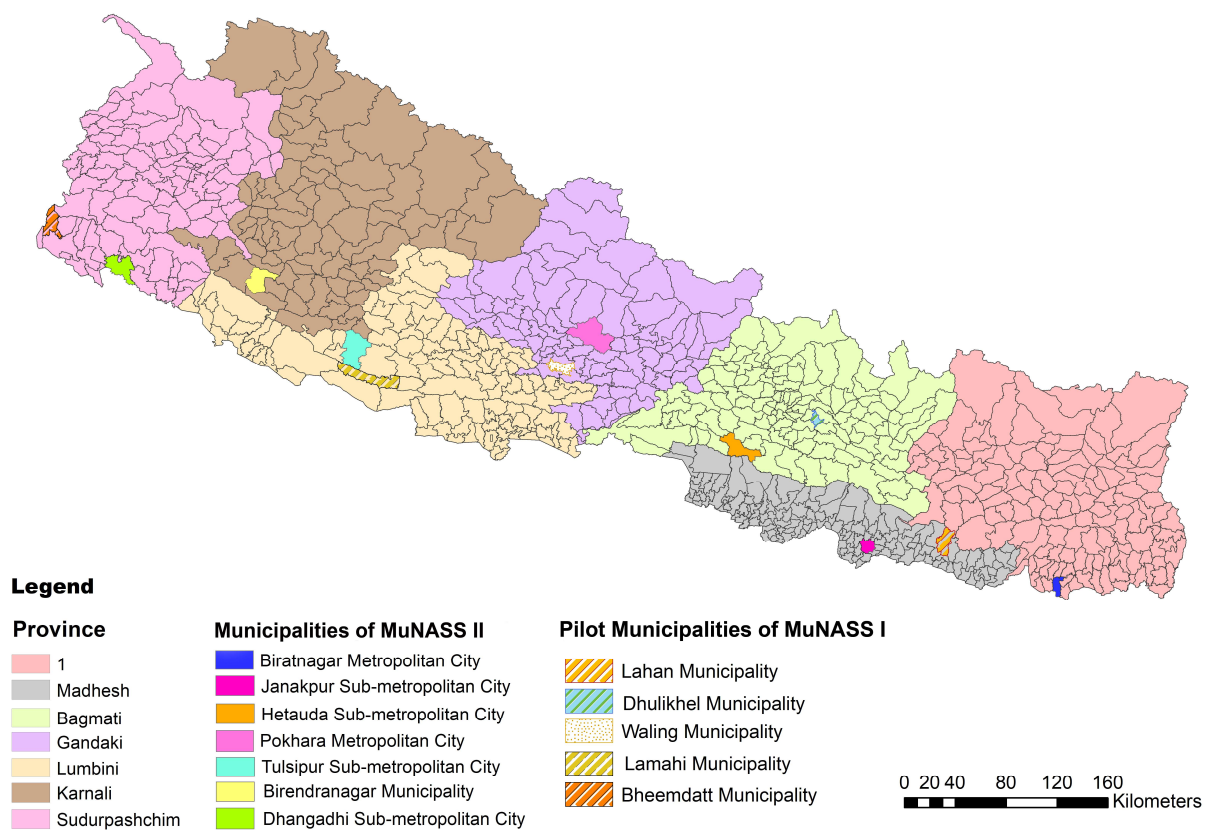
Mechanism
