
social justice in the process of urban model transformation in Vietnam

Decision No. 338/QD-TTg on approving the Project "Investment in construction of at least 01 million social housing apartments for lowincome subjects and industrial park workers in the period 2021 - 2030"

The need for social housing for low-income people and workers in industrial zones in localities in the period 2021-2030 is about 2,400,000 units.



Many commercial houses are abandoned







Who will be eligible to rent and buy social housing:

According to Housing Law 27/2023/QH15: there are 12 subjects including mainly poor people (salary not exceeding 15 million/month), poor households, workers, farmers, armed forces, civil servants,

Incentive Policies:

Land use fee exemption, tax incentives, infrastructure support around the project, loans for purchase and construction with low interest rate %, private enterprises or public investment... Social Housing Development Fund

After 5 years it will be sold as commercial housing

4. Buyers accessing the Social Housing Development Fund (low interest rate), also Investors

- 6 Green Planning & Architecture with natural energy,

7. Transparent and simple buying processes through egovernment public services,

8. City support to build of surrounding infrastructure
