IMPLEMENTING MULTI-LEVEL GOVERNANCE TO ACHIEVE THE SDGs

Maldives has implemented multi-level governance approaches to achieve the SDGs by engaging various levels of government, civil societies, and stakeholders. Maldives has the highest in records within the south Asia region in achieving SDG targets.

KEY EXPERIENCES INCLUDE:

1. National policy framework aligning with the SDGs.
2. Decentralization reforms empowering local communities and integrating their priorities.
3. Multi-stakeholder partnerships for cooperation and resource sharing.
4. Data collection and monitoring to track progress.
5. Policy coherence across sectors for effective implementation.
6. Public awareness and participation through campaigns and consultations.
7. Integration of climate change adaptation into governance frameworks.
8. Capacity building initiatives for stakeholders involved in SDG implementation.



SDG IMPLEMENTATION IN ADDU CITY



CORAL FESTIVAL 2023 HELD BY MALDIVES CORAL INSTITUTE

Objective was to promote awareness of the crucial significance of the country's coral reefs and their preservation. Also the forum was participated by International Environmental experts and champions and widely discussed for sustainable developments by preserving and protecting the beautiful nature of Addu City.



INSTALLATION OF WASTE-TO-ENERGY PLANT

To manage waste sustainably and pave the way for the resolution of waste management concerns. The waste-to-energy facility at Addu is expected to burn 50 tons of garbage per day and generate 1.5MW of power per hour.



Addu City to Convert Entirely to Renewable Energy

Addu City is set to generate all its electricity from renewable energy sources, solar panels supply renewable energy to all council buildings and mosques. Among the ongoing projects, a 10 MW solar power system is to be installed under the Aspire initiative. Under APC initiative 1.5 MW of Solar PV installed.



100000 Tree planting Initiative by the council

To make Addu city a green city and protect the environment, the council has passed a resolution to plant 100,000 coconut palms and other endangered species of plants in Addu City.

IBAMA

- Community-based organization (Ininitiation) in Maldives that collaborates with various stakeholders involved in social security.
- Training programs are conducted by the Ministry of Social and Family Development with the assistance of UNICEF.
- One of its initiatives involves forming teams of volunteers in atolls and cities across the country, excluding the Capital City Male.
- So far, Ibama has been established in 12 atolls and three cities.
