
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I. CÔTE D'IVOIRE IN BRIEF



Capacity Building

□ By 2030, ensure inclusive and equitable quality education



- Primary and secondary education is free
- Construction of college and girls' high school with boarding school
- Improving the quality of education and the efficiency of the education system



- Improving and strengthening professional training and technical education
- Eliminate all harmful practices such as female genital mutilation



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Capacity Building

- Build partnerships at the regional level in order to offer more training and skills building for all men and women, including for young people and persons with disabilities, and increase the level of technological production.
- Promotion of self-employment and entrepreneurship: Develop training programs so that young people, women and disadvantaged groups can acquire the skills needed to participate fully in the economy
- By 2030, achieve full and productive employment and decent work for all women and men, including for young people and persons with disabilities, and equal pay for work

- Ensure access to affordable, reliable, sustainable and modern energy for all (100% electricity)
- Adoption of a new environnemental code in 2023;
