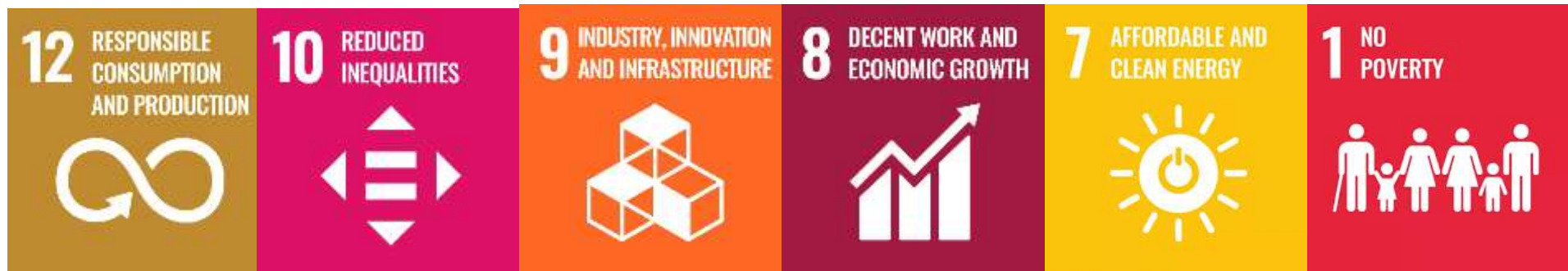

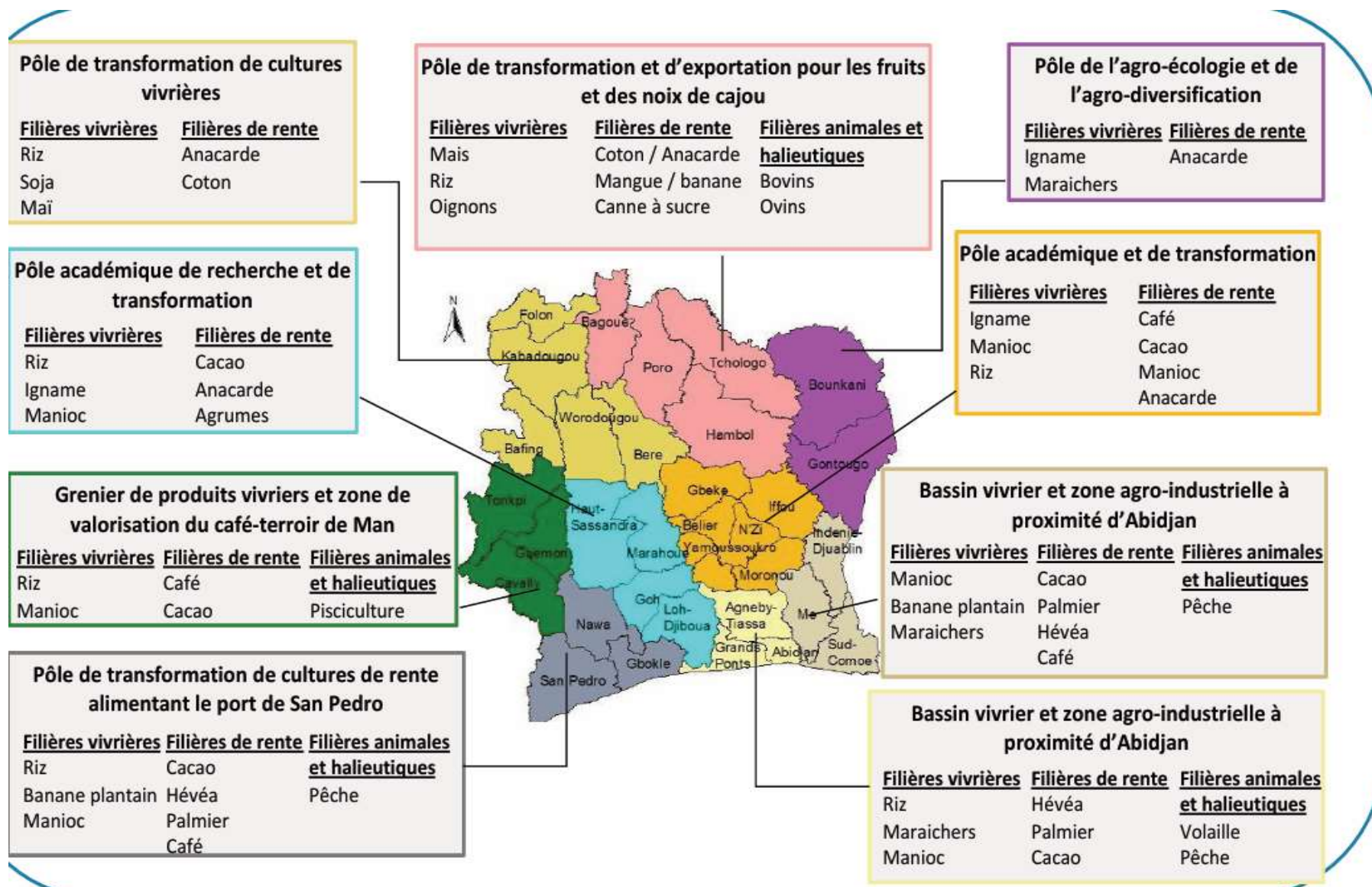

□ Eliminate all harmful practices such as female genital mutilation





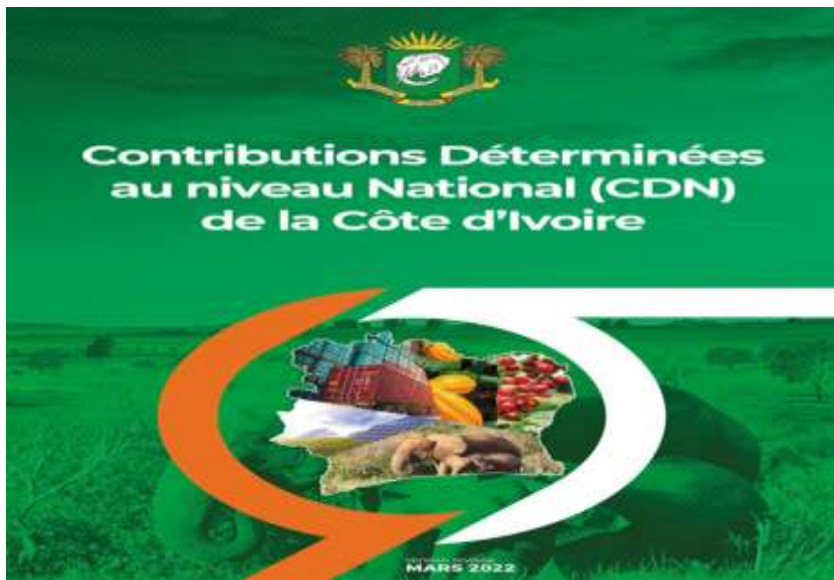


### ■ Capacity Building

- ❑ Build partnerships at the regional level in order to offer more training and skills building for all men and women, including for young people and persons with disabilities, and increase the level of technological production.
- ❑ Promotion of self-employment and entrepreneurship:  
Develop training programs so that young people, women and disadvantaged groups can acquire the skills needed to participate fully in the economy
- ❑ By 2030, achieve full and productive employment and decent work for all women and men, including for young people and persons with disabilities, and equal pay for work



## Energy, Environment and Climate Change



- ❑ Ensure access to affordable, reliable, sustainable and modern energy for all (100% electricity)
- ❑ Adoption of a new environmental code in 2023;
- ❑ NDC: 30,40% Emissions Reduction
- ❑ 45% renewable energies in the energy mix in 2030
- ❑ Construction of solar power plant, biomass power plant and construction of hydroelectric dam
