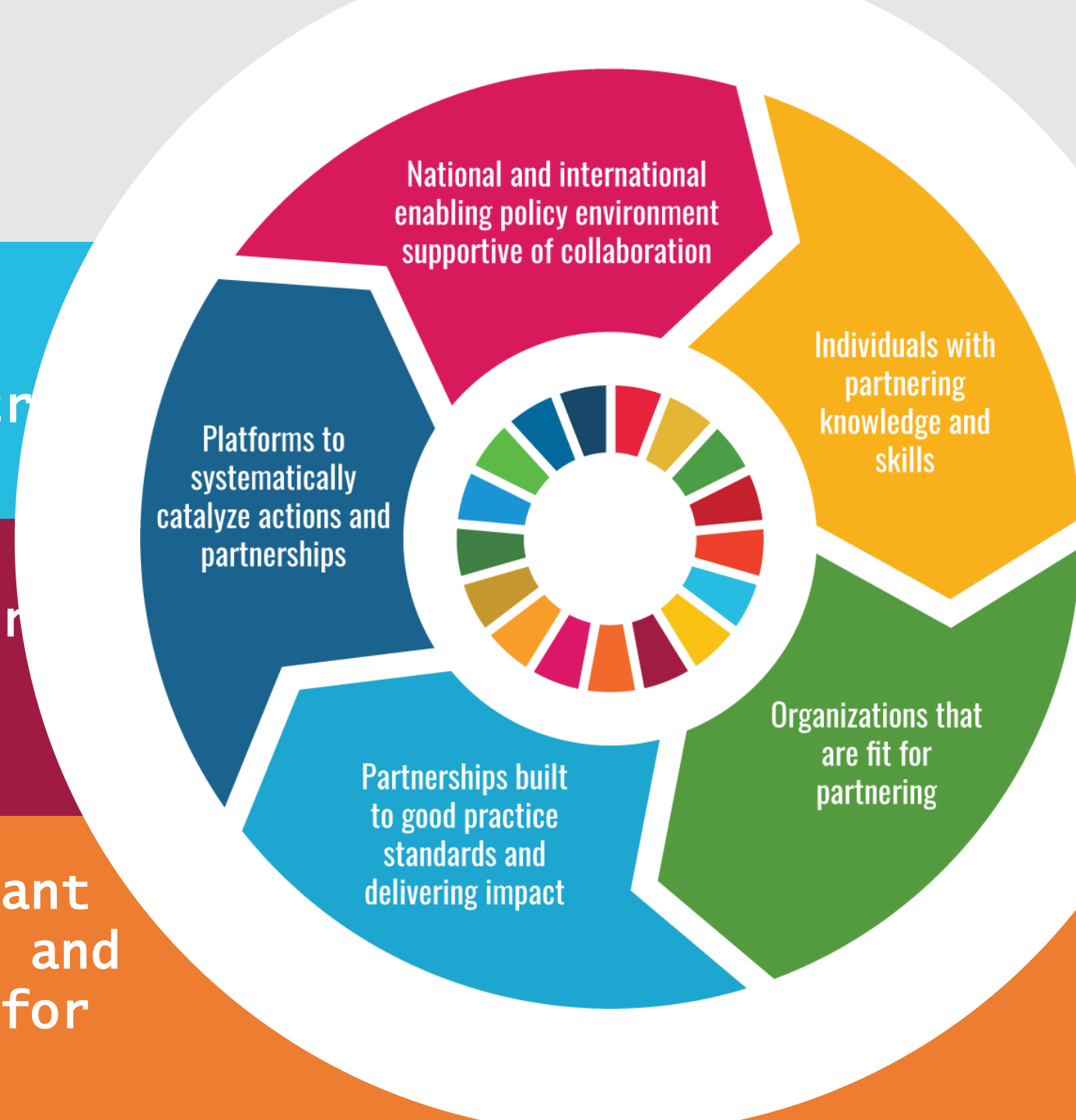

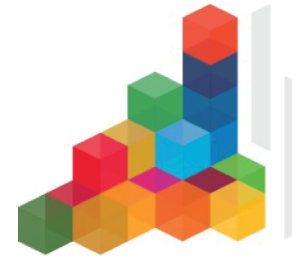

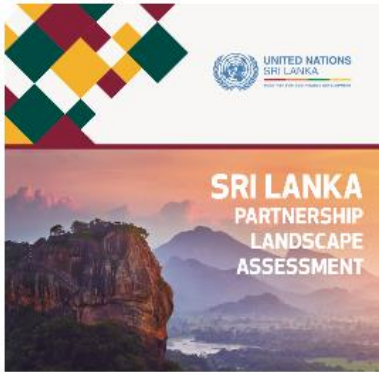

At the Forum, the Platform of Partnerships and Innovation for Territorial Sustainable Development was launched.

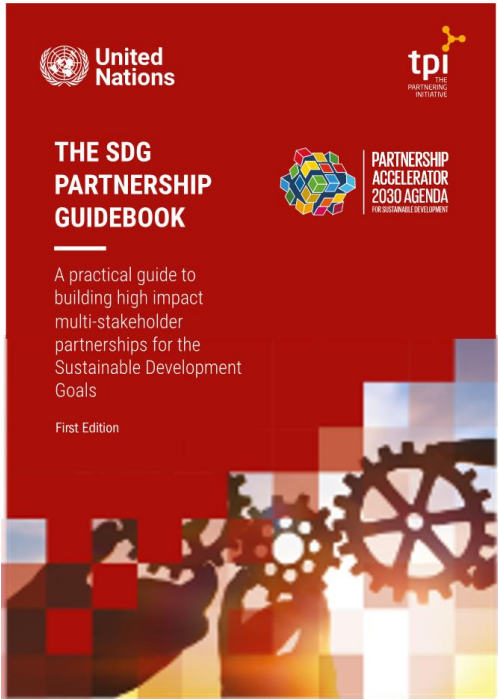
Partnerships training for Sustainable Development Goal 14 - Oceans and seas
