

Examples of Partnerships (1)

- UNESCAP Sustainable Business Network
 - Weather monitoring buoy problems
 - Placed Monitoring devices on ships
- Citypreneurs
 - Started out as a small entrepreneur bootcamp focused on SDG impacting enterprises in Korea supported by the local Seoul Government and organized by WFUNA and UNESCAP together with a initial band of investors

Examples of Partnership (2) – Korea Centric

- Korea Digital Training Centers
 - Training elderly on using digital devices and utilizing the internet and e-services

- Jeju Olle Trails
 - Creation of walking trails to promote healthy lifestyles, businesses and reduce transportation requirements.

RCEP Agreement and Free Trade

- Wide-ranging free trade agreement coming into force in early 2022.
 - Korea implemented agreement starting February 2022
 - Covers much of the Asia-Pacific region
 - Easier exports of goods, services arbitration, customs clearance etc.
