

The United Nations Office for Sustainable Development (UNOSD) was established in 2011 as a technical arm of the Division for Sustainable Development Goals (DSDG) of the United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs (UN DESA) in Incheon, Republic of Korea.

UNOSD Highlights & Activities



UNOSD and UNCRD Joint Team Capacity Building Workshop

11-12 January 2023, Incheon, Republic of Korea - In person

From 11 to 12 January 2023, UNOSD and the United Nations Centre for Regional Development (UNCRD) in Japan conducted a joint team capacity building workshop in Incheon, Republic of Korea. Through the teambuilding workshop, UNOSD and UNCRD staff were able to learn concepts and practice skills related to cross-cultural relations and communication. The sessions also included enhancing substantive skills on effective communication and presentation to further advance teamwork and individual competencies.

During the two days of intensive teambuilding workshop, UNOSD and UNCRD discussed ways to work better under multi-cultural setting, shared thoughts on organizational and professional values and aspirations, strengthened partnerships and solidarity between two offices, and enhanced individual skills and competencies that are required when working at the United Nations.

Prior to the teambuilding workshop, UNOSD conducted its own Long-term Strategy retreat from 9 to 10 January 2023 to brainstorm and consolidate the office's long-term goals. The retreat was an opportunity for UNOSD staff to strategize its future activities with more realistic targets and indicators.



5th Greenhouse Gas Inventory System Training Workshop

3-16 February 2023, Bangkok, Thailand - In person

UNOSD held the 5th Greenhouse Gas Inventory System Training Workshop in Bangkok, Thailand from 13 to 16 February 2023 to provide an opportunity for developing countries from Asia to engage in policy dialogue on utilizing national GHG inventories for designing and implementing NDCs under the Paris Agreement. The government officials and representatives, research institutions, and academia particularly from Asian countries who are involved in the development and management of national GHG inventory systems participated in the workshop.

Through the workshop, the participants enhanced their capacities on utilizing the GHG inventory system through hands-on experience on the actual GHG estimation practice based on 2006 IPCC guideline, exchanged knowledge and experiences on developing GHG inventory systems in the Asian region, and advanced networks among the participating organizations, countries, and regions.

The event was co-organized by the United Nations Office for Sustainable Development (UNOSD), United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP), and Thailand Greenhouse Gas Management Organization (TGO).

Side event at the United Nations 2023 Water Conference "Identifying and bridging the capacity gaps to achieve water-related SDGs"

23 March 2022, New York, United States - In-person

On 23 March 2023, UNOSD organized a side event at the United Nations 2023 Water Conference "Identifying and bridging the capacity gaps to achieve water-related SDGs" in New York, United States. The event was coorganized by UNOSD, the National Water and Sanitation Agency of Brazil (ANA), Korea Water Resources Corporation (K-water), UNU Institute for Water, Environment and Health (UNU-INWEH), and UNESCO International Centre for Water Security and Sustainable Management (UNESCO i-WSSM).

Focusing on identifying and filling the capacity gaps to achieve waterrelated SDGs, the side event urged the participating countries to announce a Water Action Agenda Commitment stemming from their work on SDG 6, particularly based on their experience of working in collaboration for the use of SDG 6 Policy Support System (SDG-PSS). Through the workshop, the participants enhanced their awareness on the importance of capacity building in countries for timely achievement of SDG 6, learned about SDG-PSS as a pertinent tool to create evidence on the enabling environment including capacity development around the SDG 6, shared experiences, challenges, and lessons on building national capacity for water management at the national and sub-national level, and submitted an ambitious commitment to the Water Action Agenda.


Upcoming UNOSD Programmes and Events (April - June 2023)




Our Work 2021-2022

2023 World Economic Situation and Prospects

The World Economic Situation and Prospects 2023 presents a gloomy and uncertain economic outlook for the near term. Global growth is forecast to moderately pick up to 2.7 per cent in 2024 as some of the headwinds will begin to subside. However, this is highly dependent on the pace and sequence of further monetary tightening, the course and consequences of the war in Ukraine, and the possibility of further supply-chain disruptions.


