About 90 billion soums (Uzbekistan currency) were allocated to improve the water supply and sewerage system of the Samarkand region. A comprehensive development program for 2020-2023 has been developed for Karakalpakstan. It is planned to create 27 industrial clusters operating on a system "from raw materials to finished products," the report said. Providing the Republic of Uzbekistan with a loan under the state guarantee (sovereign loan) of up to USD 60 million (EUR 50 million).
